Most of you are probably aware that a new device is being produced for the calf roping event. It is now available at the APRA head office for a cost of \$220 plus postage and handling. This device will be mandatory by the 1 March 2013. You will need to order and pay by 10 January, their contact number is 4661 8183. This will be the only device that will be accepted. You will not be allowed to compete with copies or homemade versions. For this device to work properly it needs to be set correctly so I trust that you will comply with the changes to ensure the future of your event.

I'd like to take this opportunity to thank Clive Hamrahan and Allan Flood for providing various devices for trial and for all those who gave countless hours working out which would be most appropriate and how to best set them up. A lot of work has been done to enable this event to continue and on behalf of the NRA ropers would like to say how much we appreciate the effort.

I am also making an appeal to our contractors to provide stock that would best show case this event. We need stock that gives ropers the best opportunity to look after them and so the public will be satisfied that the calves have been treated humanely.

ROOKIE AND NOVICE

Rookie Competitions:

- A Rookie is a member in their first or second year of Rodeo.
- A Rookie title can be won in their first or second year of membership.

- Points are recorded from Open Competition Only. (Rookie points are accrued in the Open Standings in the newsletter with an *R* beside the competitor's name).
- A Rookie is eligible for Novice Money until they "Break Open".

Rookie Breaks Open

- Wins a title
 - Accrues 1000 Novice points in an event
 - Completes second year of membership
- (In all of the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only)

ALL ROOKIE COMPETITORS MUST ADVISE THE OFFICE IN WRITING OF THEIR ROOKIE STATUS

Novice Competitions:

- A Novice competitor is a member competing in an event not completed in by said member and has been a financial member of NRA for at least two years.
- A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points and Novice Money until they break open and become an open member. (Novice Points do not appear in the standings in the Newsletter. All enquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the NRA Office)

Breaking Open:

As a competitor "breaks open" they will be notified in writing from the Office and recorded in the "Break Open" Register. The Competitors who have "Broken Open" will be published in the monthly Newsletter. These competitors are no longer classed as a Novice competitor and they are also no longer eligible for Novice money or points. However your Rookie (*R*) status will remain in the standings until the end of the Rodeo Season.

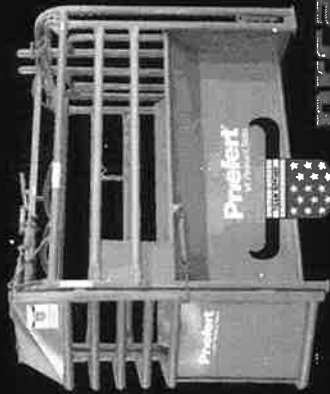

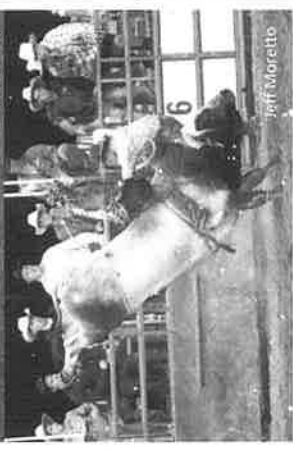

BURNIN' DOWN THE HOUSE

A full report of the hottest rodeo action in South East Qld.

An action packed month of rodeo capped off the 2012 rodeo season for the National Rodeo Association.

Alstonville bull ride saw competitors turn out to tie for some of the last available points for the season with open bull ride competitors taking on two head.

The eventual winner was the man on a mission to claim the 2012 bull riding title, in Cameron Taylor who scored 82 points to be ahead of John Foster, Daniel Piggott and Matt Boland.

From two sections of novice bull riding it was Gabe Wood who would take home the entire purse as the only rider to stay on top for the required eight seconds while the junior bull ride saw just two qualified rides in that of winner Jack McArthur with 70 points and Jordan Everingham with 68. Lane Heaton, Dylan Talbot, Clay Hall and Brenton Kuhrt took out the junior steer ride with Lane backing up his strong performance in the open local steer ride to place second behind John Foster.

Next competitors rolled into Goomboongee Showgrounds for the annual rodeo which would become the last event to gather points before the finals with the Greenbank Wildside Series event scheduled for the following weekend cancelled due to rain.

A full open rodeo was held on Saturday November 3 with a full junior rodeo held on the Sunday.

Open bull rider became somewhat of a home town hero as he claimed victory in his pet event not far from home with an 82 point ride while in the saddle bronc Michael Maher also scored in the low 80's to be top of the table.

Meantime in the bareback Ashley Clem continued his unstoppable form to win the event ahead of a tough field. In the team roping 2012 champion combination, header Luke Gail and header Jesse Townsend had a smoking run to set a new NRA record at 5.070.

Other winners to stop the clock quickly were Adam Purse

with a 9.531 in the rope and tie and Dallas Lange in the steer wrestling with a 4.437.

The first round of the finals at Ipswich were severely affected by rain but events which were unable to be run on the day were held before the performance commenced at round two the following weekend.

Cheyenne Whitwell was a standout performer taking out both the open and junior barrel race for the third year in a row.

As the only competitor to ride time in the bull ride Jayden Simms didn't have to worry about sharing the prize money with anyone.

The following weekend finals competitors travelled to Nambour, where the crowd witnessed eventual bull ride finals average winner James Hayes put up an 80 point ride to win the round while fellow finals average winner Jordan O'Neill got the win in the steer wrestling with a time of 4.210.

Luke Gail and Jesse Townsend left the box firing to win the team roping with a 6.044 second run which further cemented their position for their title wins for 2012.

Meantime competition in the steer undecorating was tough with Denae Hart taking the win on 1.727 with Kerri-Anne Young right on her tail for second with 1.759 seconds.

At the third and final round of the finals at Caboolture competitors were greeted with an enthusiastic crowd which no doubt assisted in some great year end performances.

One such performance came from Kyle Williams to win the steer wrestling in 4.219 seconds.

The barrel race was a very close event with Maddison Swan taking first place with a 15.996 second run and Skye Evans coming in second on 15.998 seconds.

With the bucking of the last bull at the Caboolture event came the conclusion of the 2012 National Rodeo Association competition year.

JUNIORS IN RODEO

IMPORTANT RULES

All Juniors (including Day Members) must have suitable proof of age available on the day, should there be a need for verification. Junior Competitors who compete in any Junior and or Open Rodeo Events:

- TIME EVENT JUNIOR COMPETITORS:**
Must wear properly fitted AUSTRALIAN APPROVED HELMET with chin straps fastened at all times during the ride
- ROUGH STOCK JUNIOR COMPETITORS:**
Must wear properly fitted FULL FACE PROTECTIVE HELMET WITH CHIN STRAP FASTENED UP AT ALL TIMES during the ride
- Your helmet must be appropriately adjusted to fit you and chin straps fastened up before you ride. Chute Boss and or Officials may request to inspect the helmet.
- Approved properly fitted protective VEST.**
If this request is not met, you will not be granted the ride and your stock will be turned out.
- These rules include All Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.
- If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you MUST STILL ABIDE BY THE Junior rules when competing in Junior events*.
- Juniors competing in OPEN EVENTS MUST HAVE AN UPGRADED Open Membership as Junior membership only entitles you to compete in Junior events.
- If you wish to compete in an Open event you must UPGRADE your membership to Open Membership: Other Men's and Ladies' Open Membership of \$110.00 (from \$44.00 to \$154.00) and plus bond of \$60.00 (from \$15.00 to \$75.00).
- *NOTE:** If there is not a Junior event the same as the event you wish to compete in, you may compete in the Open event by paying Open day membership. However, with option you are not entitled to receive points, only prize money.

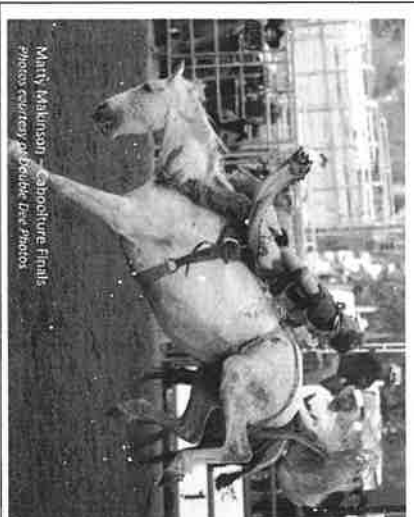

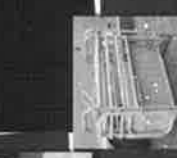
