

# **2013 MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL NOTICE**

- Membership renewals are now due for the NRA 2013 Rodeo Season.
- This applies to all members of the NRA: To compete, officiate and stock contract at a rodeo, members must be financial.
- Membership Renewals must be paid & processed through the NRA Office only not at Rodeos.
- Membership Renewals received after Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> February, 2013 at the close of NRA business hours (3pm), will attract a late fee of \$11.00 per person
- Membership must be paid prior to competing in any rodeos for 2013 Rodeo Season.
   Competitors who have not yet paid their membership in full for the current rodeo season will NOT BE ENTITLED TO NOMINATE for any upcoming rodeos.
- As per NRA Rule Book Resignation of membership must be in writing. When resignation is not received in writing or membership is not renewed by 31<sup>st</sup> March 2013, membership will be cancelled and bond will be forfeited automatically.
- A person is not eligible to compete on a day membership for a period of three (3) months if they have resigned or their membership has been forfeited.

## NRA RULE BOOK CHANGES

as of 1st January 2013

Below are some of the rules to be updated in our new rule book currently awaiting printing.

- 1) Breakaway Roping
  - a. To increase the number of strings used to 4 (four) pieces.
- 2) Time Event Contractors
  - a. Steer Wrestling stock
    - i. Steer Wrestling Cattle horns shall be a minimum 225mm on both horns. The measurement will be from the base of the horn to the tip of the horn. The horn spread of cattle shall be no more than 750mm from Tip to Tip unless approved by the Event Director. Stock Contractors are expected to cooperate in trimming cattle's horns to allow them to freely pass through the Time Event Box.
  - ii. The above rules also applies to Steer Undecorating Stock (where cattle have horns)
- 3) Rope & Tie
  - a. It is mandatory for Rope & Tie competitors to use the devise for the event.
- 4) Junior Members
  - a. Junior Members must be 17yrs and under as of the  $\mathbf{1}^{st}$  of January.
- 5) The final decision on cancelling a rodeo or stopping a rodeo due to weather or ground condition must be done by NRA Directors.
- 6) Affiliated Committees:
  - Judges, Time Keepers and Chute Boss are to be appointed from the NRA approved official list published in the monthly NRA Newsletter.
  - b. All NRA approved rodeos must have two (2) NRA approved Judges and one (1) NRA approved timekeeper for Points Award/Bull Ride rodeo and two (2) NRA approved timekeepers for All Round Rodeo and one (1) NRA approved Chute Boss.
- All rules apply to the parents and/or guardians of junior competitors and they are therefore subject to the same disciplinary action.

Campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a Property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

#### **ROOKIE AND NOVICE**

#### Rookie Competition:

- A Rookie is a member in their first or second year of Rodeo.
- A Rookie Title can be won in their first or second year of membership.
- Points are accrued from <u>Open Competition Only</u>. (Rookie points are recorded in the Open Standings in the newsletter with an \*R\* beside the competitor's name).
- A Rookie is eligible for Novice Money until they "Break Open".

#### Rookie Breaks Open

- 1. Wins a title
- 2. Accrues 1000 Novice points in an event
- 3. Completes second year of membership (In all of the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only.

#### ALL ROOKIE COMPETITORS MUST ADVISE THE OFFICE IN WRITING OF THEIR ROOKIE STATUS

#### **Novice Competition:**

- A Novice competitor is a member competing in an event not completed in by said member and has been a financial member of NRA for at least two years.
- A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points and Novice Money until they break open and become an open member. (Novice Points do not appear in the standings in the Newsletter. All enquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the NRA Office)

#### Breaking Open:

As a competitor "Breaks Open" they will be notified in writing from the Office and recorded in the "Break Open" Register. The Competitors who have "Broken Open" will be published in the monthly Newsletter. These competitors are no longer classed as a Novice Competitor and they are also no longer eligible for Novice money or points. However your Rookie (\*R\*) status will remain in the standings until the end of the Rodeo Season.





The last year was without a doubt the most difficult I have ever experienced as a Sports Administrator. We as a Board seem to be spending the biggest amount of meeting time discussing minor petty members' grievances, whilst not attending to the bigger picture.

Our year started poorly with weather problems not unlike 2011, this has a major effect on the companies financial income early in a new season. The loss of two major money contributors in 2011 namely the bar at both Urban Music and the Caboolture Finals amount to a significant loss of revenue. On investigation a huge number of members had been using the Association as a financial institution or a bank by failing to pay membership, entries and fines. Changes have been implemented to ensure this will not occur in the future.

A number of incidents took place during 2012 which were passed on to our Judiciary Panel for their investigation and action. Whilst not everyone will be happy with the end result of the findings, we must thank all those that contributed by donating time and effort in supporting the cause. Might I suggest all this waste of money not to mention the effort of many, if every member showed a small amount of thought and avoided senseless actions that not only embarrass themselves, family and do untold damage to the image of the industry. I make an appeal to everyone to let 2013 be a judiciary free year.

Facebook once again has not been without its extremely high rate of inaccurate and highly offensive comments, which do little except make the originator look like a goose. If these so called do gooders put their efforts to being positive the world would be a far happier place and just maybe so would they. Having said all that, any member that offends will be dealt with.

Two Executives resigned during the year, as of now no replacements have taken place. Dale Frahm was the first to resign, his was forced by a campaign generated by contractors laying a claim of conflict of interest. Dale in his letter of resignation state he was standing down in the best interest of the N.R.A. and to take the pressure off me. Shandelle Voll was the second to resign. Shandelle's letter stated a lack of support by the Board. I along with the majority of Board members do not agree with her reason, at no stage did we not support Shandelle. We do however have to follow judicial procedures. On behalf of the Board and Members, we thank both Shandelle and Dale for their contribution and wish them all the best for the future.

Committees and promoters are a major contributor to the success of any rodeo association and the N.R.A. is no exception. We are grateful for the wonderful support shown by this group of rodeo people. I must make special mention of our Finals Committees: Brothers Rugby League – Jason, Steve; Nambour Show Society – Tony, Rohan; Caboolture Show Society – Alf. I have only mentioned a small number of finals contacts, there are many more and we thank you all.

A special mention and a vote of thanks to the office staff Indra, what would we do without you. Angie, our newest member, welcome. Tabatha and Terri both have moved on, we thank them for their contribution. To the Board of Directors, yours is a thankless task however if we work as a team my belief is so much can be accomplished, so hang in and I thank you all.

#### Stacey Ebert - Executive Director's - Legals and Insurance 2012

This year has seen no formal legal or insurance claims filed against the Association and we are pleased to have amicably settled an insurance claim filed against the NRA from last year.

There have been various complaints submitted to the NRA that have required legal work to be undertaken and have consumed countless hours of the Board's time this year. The Board accepts the rights of its members to submit complaints but would like members to be aware that the enormous amount of time spent on reviewing and dealing with these matters only serves to decrease the time that the Board can spend on ways to grow and further the Association.

Earlier in 2012 the Board met to agree upon changes required to the Rule Book with a view to those changes taking effect for the 2013 season. Various proposals in relation the events such as Rope and Tie and other matters have seen the completion and production of the amended Rule Book put on hold. This decision was made to avoid the unnecessary work and expense of compiling a new Rule Book that would likely be superseded within a very short time. Once these matters are resolved, the Board will be in a position to finalise the Rule Book and distribute it to the members. In the meantime, some of the critical rule changes that have been agreed will be published in the next edition of Sports News and will take effect from that point on. Please read that notice carefully to ensure you are up to date with all rules and raise any queries you may have with the relevant director. We appreciate that this has been a long process and thank you for your continued understanding and cooperation while the Rule Book is being finalised.

#### NRA AGM DIRECTORS REPORTS

I would like to take this opportunity to remind members that the Board are all volunteers and that the "free" membership they receive pales in comparison to the time and effort they put in to running this Association. Despite what some members think, the work that the Board does is not to advance their own positions but simply to ensure that each and every one of you can turn up and compete in the sport you love every weekend.

Very few people understand the time that various Directors put in behind the scenes. I dread to count the hours I have spent over the last few years attending Board meetings, various other insurance and legal related meetings, drafting letters, providing advice, fielding phone calls etc. During my time on the Board, the Association has not incurred any legal costs whatsoever which is a substantial saving for a non-profit organisation that allows it to continue to reward its members with high quality awards and trophies.

A very special mention must go to Bill who spends countless hours every week attending meetings and dealing with matters that the vast majority wouldn't even know exist. I am aware of much that he does however, I could only begin to imagine the full extent of what he has done over the years and what he will continue to do for the NRA. Bill is instrumental to this Association and his knowledge and hard work is irreplaceable.

All members are entitled to voice their concerns, raise issues and make complaints to the Association and its directors however, there is an appropriate way for members to do so. Moving forward, I encourage our members to consider what has been said and to act in a way that is not only appropriate in the circumstances but that takes into account not only their personal interests, but those of the Association as a whole.

Recently, I saw a quote that said "I often think 'Why doesn't someone do something about that?' Then I realised I am someone". As the Association is constantly short of directors, it would be great to see more members put their hand up to take on a role on the Board which would not only help the Association but would enable more people to gain an understanding and appreciation for the hard work and dedication of our directors.

Due to the upcoming birth of our first child, I have decided not to accept a re-appointment to the Executive Board for the 2013 season. I would like to thank the Board and in particular, Bill, Luke and Indra for their constant support during my time as Executive Director and wish them, the Board and the Association the very best for the future.

In 2012, the breakaway roping competitors saw a few changes put in place with regards to flag judging and string. Any competitors who are deemed as to pulling their ropes off the saddle horn after they have roped their calf will be disqualified. This has been a long standing rule with the National Rodeo Association, and it was brought to my attention at the start of the season, that some competitors were not abiding by this rule. I held a meeting with all Breakaway competitors at Dayboro Rodeo in May, and explained this on behalf of the flag judges.

Also discussed at this meeting, was the quality and quantity of string to be used. A new rule was passed by the Board in 2012 to increase the amount of string to be used to 4 pieces. This rule was to come into effect once the new rule book was published, but due to this being delayed this rule as well as a few more will be published in the next monthly newsletter. This rule will be taken into effect as of Alstonville All Round Rodeo held at the end of February.

Once again, the 2012 season was a great one. The Breakaway competition was a tight one right up until the finals, with Kim Clarke winning the title. It's great to see that each year the Breakaway is still open slather until the finals, and the quality of breakaway roping is at an all-time high. I would also like to thank TuffRock and Katie B Western as our two sponsors for 2012.

With regards to the NRA Marketing campaign, in 2012 it was discussed with the Board, to upgrade the current NRA website, this is still in the production stages and will go live once final board approval is given. Junior Competitors who compete in any Junior and or Open **Rodeo Events:** 

- **TIME EVENT JUNIOR COMPETITORS:** Must wear properly fitted AUSTRALIAN APPROVED HELMET with chin straps fastened at all times during the ride
- **ROUGH STOCK JUNIOR COMPETITORS:** Must wear properly fitted FULL FACE PROTECTIVE **HELMET WITH CHIN STRAP FASTENED UP AT ALL TIMES** during the ride

Your helmet must be appropriately adjusted to fit you and chin straps fastened up before you ride. Chute Boss and or Officials may request to inspect the helmet.

- Approved properly fitted protective VEST. If this request is not met, you will not be granted the ride and your stock will be turned out.
- These rules include All Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.
- If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you Must STILL ABIDE BY THE Junior rules when competing in Junior events\*.
- Juniors competing in OPEN EVENTS MUST HAVE AN **UPGRADED Open Membership as Junior membership** only entitles you to compete in Junior events.
- If you wish to compete in an Open event you must UPGRADE your membership to Open Membership: Other Men's and Ladies' Open Membership of \$110.00 (from \$44.00 to \$154.00) and plus bond of \$60.00 (from \$15.00 to \$75.00).
- \*NOTE: If there is not a Junior event the same as the event you wish to compete in, you may compete in the Open event by paying Open day membership. However, with option you are not entitled to receive points, only prize money.

To kick off the year NRA competitors went head to head with ABCRA competitors at the annual dual affiliated Lawrence twilight rodeo.

Of the NRA competitors to star were first and second place getters in the bull ride Jeff Moretto and Matt Boland who took their places with 82 and 81 point rides respectively.

Michael Maher and Dave Mawhinney kept representing NRA in the saddle bronc leader board, tying for second on 75 points. Good friends Matty Makinson and Dinny Moran stepped in the winner's circle in the open bareback with 77 and 69 points rides to place them third and fourth respectively.

The time event end of the arena was dominated by ABCRA competitors however Judy Gough stepped into third place in the breakaway roping with a slick 2.86 run.

Meantime at Goomeri New Year's Eve rodeo it was once again Jeff Moretto who took out the open bull ride with a solid 81 point ride followed by Cameron Taylor, Ryan Dickens and PJ Bradford.

Jim Ryan took out the saddle bronc with an 80 point ride while Dinny Moran won the bareback and PJ Bradford the novice bull ride.

At the time event end of the arena it was Cheyenne Whitwell who once again took home the lions share of the prize money with a win in the open and junior barrel race.

Veteran competitor Alan Knox showed he hasn't lost any form by taking out the rope and tie on 11.250 seconds. A full program junior rodeo followed on New Year's Day with good competition shown by all competitors. On January 5 the rodeo road train headed to the coast for the Noosa Pirates Leagues Club event which saw Jim Ryan once again take out the open saddle bronc, this time with a 75.5 point ride.

Matty Makinson showed the style which makes him a champion in the bareback ride to take the win with 82 points. Further south at Cudgen Leagues Club on January 5 it was in form junior competitor Jack McArthur who stepped up to take out the open bull ride with well put together 77 point ride as well as being the only score in the junior bull ride on 70 points. Cameron Taylor took out the open saddle bronc on 69 points while PJ Bradford conquered two head to win the novice bull ride on 143 points.

Following this, rodeo just kept heading south for the Byron Bay rodeo on January 10 where seasoned competitors Martin Carlo and Mark Collins, took out the open bull ride and saddle bronc respectively.

In the open barrel race Cheyenne Whitwell flew around the drums in just 12.851 seconds to take the win from Jamie Cottam, Katie Vaughan and Kate O'Dea.






