ROOKIE AND NOVICE

Rookie Competition:

- A Rookie is a member in their first or second year of Rodeo.
- A Rookie Title can be won in their first or second year of membership.
- Points are accrued from Open Competition Only. (Rookie points are recorded in the Open Standings in the newsletter with an *R* beside the competitor's name).
- A Rookie is eligible for Novice Money until they "Break Open".

Rookie Breaks Open

1. Wins a title
 2. Accrues 1000 Novice points in an event
 3. Completes second year of membership
- (In all of the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only.)

ALL ROOKIE COMPETITORS MUST ADVISE THE OFFICE IN WRITING OF THEIR ROOKIE STATUS

Novice Competition:

- A Novice competitor is a member competing in an event not competed in by said member and has been a financial member of NRA for at least two years.
- A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points and Novice Money until they break open and become an open member. (Novice Points do not appear in the standings in the Newsletter. All enquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the NRA Office)

Breaking Open:

As a competitor "Breaks Open" they will be notified in writing from the Office and recorded in the "Break Open" Register. The Competitors who have "Broken Open" will be published in the monthly Newsletter. These competitors are no longer classed as a Novice Competitor and they are also no longer eligible for Novice money or points. However your Rookie (*R*) status will remain in the standings until the end of the Rodeo Season.

IMPORTANT RULES

All Juniors (including Day Members) must have suitable proof of age available on the day, should there be a need for verification.

Junior Competitors who compete in any Junior and or Open Rodeo Events:

- **TIME EVENT JUNIOR COMPETITORS:**
Must wear properly fitted AUSTRALIAN APPROVED HELMET with chin straps fastened at all times during the ride
- **ROUGH STOCK JUNIOR COMPETITORS:**
Must wear properly fitted FULL FACE PROTECTIVE HELMET WITH CHIN STRAP FASTENED UP AT ALL TIMES during the ride
Your helmet must be appropriately adjusted to fit you and chin straps fastened up before you ride. Chute Boss and or Officials may request to inspect the helmet.
- **Approved properly fitted protective VEST. If this request is not met, you will not be granted the ride and your stock will be turned out.**
- These rules include All Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.
- If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you Must STILL ABIDE BY THE Junior rules when competing in Junior events*.
- Juniors competing in OPEN EVENTS MUST HAVE AN UPGRADED Open Membership as Junior membership only entitles you to compete in Junior events.
- If you wish to compete in an Open event you must UPGRADE your membership to Open Membership: Other Men's and Ladies'
Open Membership of \$110.00 (from \$44.00 to \$154.00) and plus bond of \$60.00 (from \$15.00 to \$75.00).
- ***NOTE:** If there is not a Junior event the same as the event you wish to compete in, you may compete in the Open event by paying Open day membership. However, with option you are not entitled to receive points, only prize money.

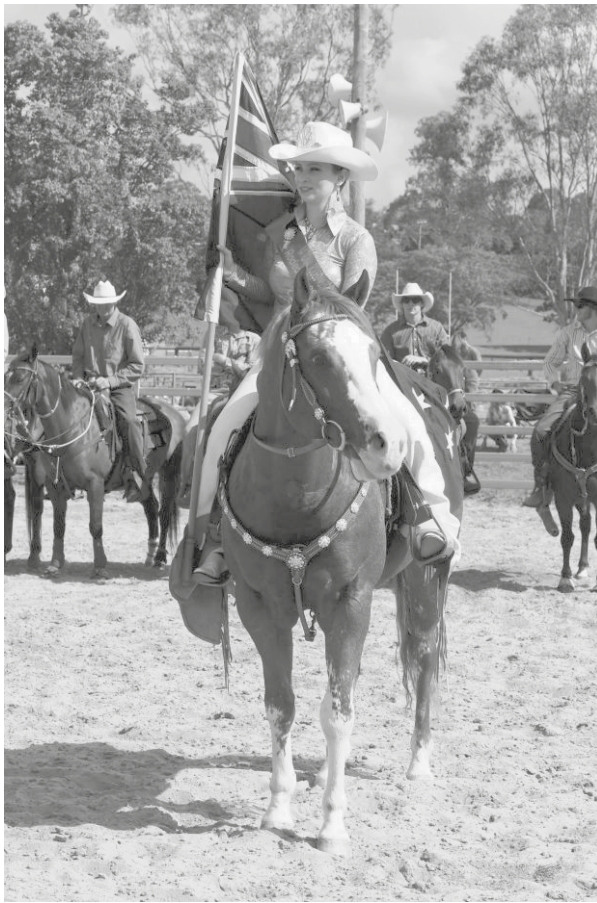

NOTES FROM THE OFFICE

FAREWELL TO BILL URQUHART

Tuesday 14 May 2013 marked the end of an era with long serving Executive Director, Bill Urquhart, resigning from his position on the National Rodeo Association (NRA) Executive Board. This year marked 40th anniversary of Bill's introduction to the Board of Directors of the NRA (formerly the South East Queensland Rodeo Riders Association).



Bill first entered the rodeo scene at the age of 17. One of the highlights of his competition career was being invited to compete in front of Queen Elizabeth and Prince Phillip in 1963 at the Brisbane Showgrounds.

Bill was a foundation member of the newly formed South East Queensland Rodeo Riders Association (SEQRRA) in 1966 and was first appointed to the Board of Directors, as the Stock Contractor's representative, in 1973. This appointment was the start of a long and successful tenure in rodeo administration.

In 1979 Bill was voted in as President of SEQRRA. He stood down from this position in 1984, but remained on the board. The following year he again assumed the role of President and was still at the helm in 1988 when the association changed its name to the National Rodeo Association.

One of Bill's last duties on behalf of the NRA was to assist with the formation of the Australian Rodeo Federation, another key milestone in the sport of Rodeo in Australia.

The Executive Board would like to thank Bill for his many hours of hard work and dedication to not only the NRA but the sport of rodeo over the last 40 years. All the best Bill!

Ropersmate™ Calf Roping Device (Part # 8700544) - Instructions For Use

WARNING: This device is for use with animals only. It is NOT to be used as a descent device for human use. The device is intended for use by trained professionals, skilled in the art of calf roping only.

INTRODUCTION

The Ropersmate™ calf roping device is a unique product that has been developed in conjunction with industry to reduce the risk of injury on both horses and cattle (mainly calves) during rodeo events. The Ropersmate™ works as a 'shock absorber', to lessen the force experienced by both the horse and calf, when the rope lasso tightens against the calf's neck, prior to the rider leaving the horse to throw and tie off.

The Ropersmate™ is fabricated from high strength anodised aluminium and is attached to the rider's saddle horn. The lasso rope is threaded through the device with a backstopper knot to prevent the rope from running through the end. The device has demonstrated high durability during all field testing and will provide many years of service for the riding professional.

INDUSTRY ENDORSEMENT

The Ropersmate™ device has been endorsed by the **Australian Professional Rodeo Association (APRA)** and the **Australian Bushmen's Campdraft & Rodeo Association (ABCRA)** as a standard minimum equipment requirement for competition in all Australian based rodeo calf roping events. For further information about these requirements, contact these organisations directly.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR RIGGING

The roping of the device is relatively simple, and requires 4 simple steps as follows:

1. Inspect Ropersmate™ device prior to use. Inspect for cracks, burrs, missing components or any deformities. In the event any of these are found, the device should not be used.
2. Grab the Ropersmate™ and place the saddle connection end at the top (round hole end). Loosen the gate screw to allow it to slide. Thread a standard competition lasso rope into the device in two stages as follows:

Stage 1



Stage 2



3. Slide the gate to the closed position and tighten. Now attach the Ropersmate™ to the saddle horn, using the 6mm rope cord tied on the head. Ensure device is tied securely to saddle horn to prevent slipping off during use.



4. Ensure correct rope tail extension is in place, relative to the size of animal for roping. Always ensure rope tail length between the Ropersmate™ device and knot **is a minimum of 300mm**. For calves over 110 kg, a tail longer than 300mm but less than 600mm is recommended. The device is **NOT** recommended for use on cattle over 200kg. Refer to general use warnings for further information. You are now ready to go.

GENERAL USE WARNINGS

1. Failure to thread rope correctly through the device may cause device not to function correctly as designed.

2. Keep all loose clothing and hair away from device. This includes the horse's mane - it is recommended the horse's mane close to the device be clipped short to avoid entanglement.
3. Rodeo competition event requirements may vary. Always check with the event organisers as to the use of the Ropersmate™ device prior to competing in any event.

CARE & USE CONDITIONS

The Ropersmate™ Calf Roping Device must be visually and manually inspected before and after each use to verify that the device is fit for use. During the pre-use inspection you must ensure:

- A) There are no cracks or deformation to the body, gate or latch, or any other part of the device;
- B) The gate is secure and operates as designed;
- C) The latch operates smoothly and as designed such that the gate cannot be opened without the operation of the latch;
- D) Rigging holes are round with no elongation or damage to the hole indicating excessive loading;
- E) There is no corrosion or excessive grime which would hamper the operation of the device or its components;
- F) Where the device comes into contact with chemicals, the unit needs to be cleaned as soon as practicable and inspected for any surface damage to the finish and metals;
- G) Care is taken when using the device in adverse weather, the recommended temperature range of -40°, +80° Celsius. Ice and snow must be cleared from the operational area to ensure smooth operation.

WARRANTY

Warranty to End User: Rope It warrants to the original end user ("End User") that the Ropersmate™ calf roping device is free from defects in materials and workmanship under normal use and service. This warranty extends for 1 year from the date the product is purchased by the End User, in new and unused condition, from a Rope It authorised distributor. This warranty is provided in addition to other rights and remedies available to the End User under law.

Rope It will not accept liability for defects that result from product abuse, misuse, alteration or modification, or for defects that are due to a failure to install, maintain or use the product according to the prescribed instructions.

The product comes with guarantees that cannot be excluded under Australian Consumer Law. The End User is entitled to a replacement or refund for a major failure and to compensation for any other reasonably foreseeable loss or damage. The End User is also entitled to have the product repaired or replaced if the product fails to be of acceptable quality and the failure does not amount to a major failure.

Limitation of Liability:

To the extent permitted by law:

- a) Rope It's maximum liability to the End User for failure to comply with a consumer guarantee in respect of the supply of the product not of a kind ordinarily acquired for personal, domestic or household use or consumption is limited, at Rope It's sole discretion, to repair or replacement of the product; and

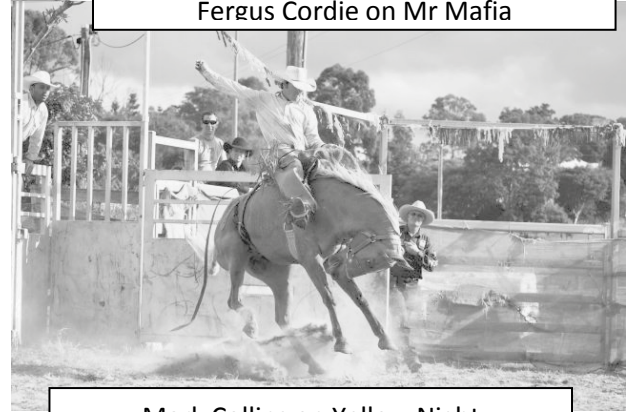
RULES FOR CALF ROPING DEVICE

- Rope sizes to be 10.25, 10.5 or 10.75.
- Rope to be threaded through device as show in instructional photo.
- No ropes to be connected to the saddle horn.
- Device can only be tied on to horn using either a leather strap or nylon rope.
- Knot to be tied in one end of rope and then rope dyed with red dye, 300mm length from knot, so it will be clearly visible for the barrier judge to check.
- No ropes to be joined. The rope being used must be the rope running through the device with 300mm of tail clearly hanging out of device.
- In the unfortunate incident of a jerkdown (jerkdown rules still apply) you will be directed by the judges to wait in a position within full view of the barrier judge or a director until the round finishes. At this time a judge will check your rope and device. If the device is found to have been changed in any way you will face a fine of \$500 and a suspension.

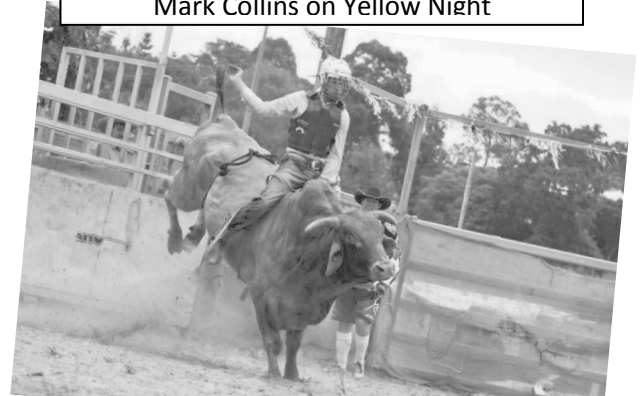

A full report of the hottest rodeo action in South East Qld.

Oakey rodeo finished off a busy month of rodeo action in South East Queensland for April.

The event saw Matt Gakowski take out the Open Bull ride with a solid 82 point ride while Jack Capewell led in the Saddle Bronc rider with a score of 76 points with Matty Makinson taking out the bareback with a score of 76.

In the Junior events on the night 2012 Junior Bull riding champion Jack McArthur stepped up to take home first position in his pet event while Zane Hall led in the Poddy Riders.

Rodeos for May kicked off with the Urban Country event which was this year reduced from and all around rodeo to a points award event.

Jeffrey Morretto won the Open Bull ride with an impressive 84 point ride while the Saddle Bronc was a close contest with Peter Carswell and Cameron Taylor tying for first place on 73 points.

Matty Makinson and Jack McArthur took out their second win in as many weekends by winning the Bareback Bronc ride and Junior Bull ride respectively while Dan Ruhland took home first place in the poddy ride.

The next day bull riders headed west to Goondiwindi for the annual Bull ride event which saw Ryan Dickens take home over \$1500 for an 82 point ride which landed him in first place.

The next day at Dayboro All Round event Open Bull ride winner Keelan Alexander also took home over \$1500 as the only scorer on the day.

Peter Carswell scored 80 points to win the Saddle Bronc ahead of Mark Collins, Jack Capewell and John McNamee.

In the Bareback Bronc ride Matty Makinson led them in.

There were a number of fast times recorded at the time event end of the arena with Jesse Townsend going 9.881 seconds in the Rope and Tie, Brad Cavanagh 4.007 in the Steer Wrestling, Katie Vaughan 2.494 in the Breakaway Roping.

The month of May also saw the Regional Circuit Challenge at Bundaberg between NRA and CRCA where a number of NRA competitors took out event honours including Ryan Dickens in the Bull Ride, Michael Maher in the Saddle Bronc, Katie Vaughan in the Barrel Race and Dave Mawhinney in the Steer Wrestling.

At Brookfield Bull ride Frazer Babbington showed great form to be 86 points in the Open Bull ride, a score which was not touched and saw him win the event.

Gympie All Round event was next on the calendar with home town cowboy Ashley Clem putting up the ride of the night in the Bareback Bronc ride to be 80 points and take the win.

Other strong performers on the day were Kylie Siebenhausen who won the Open and Junior Barrel Race as well as placing second in the Open Breakaway Roping as Matthew Young who won the Open and Novice Bull ride.

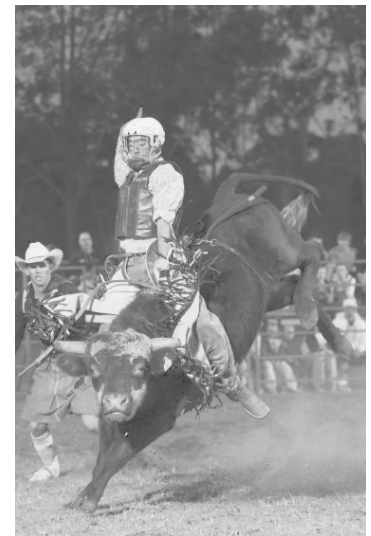

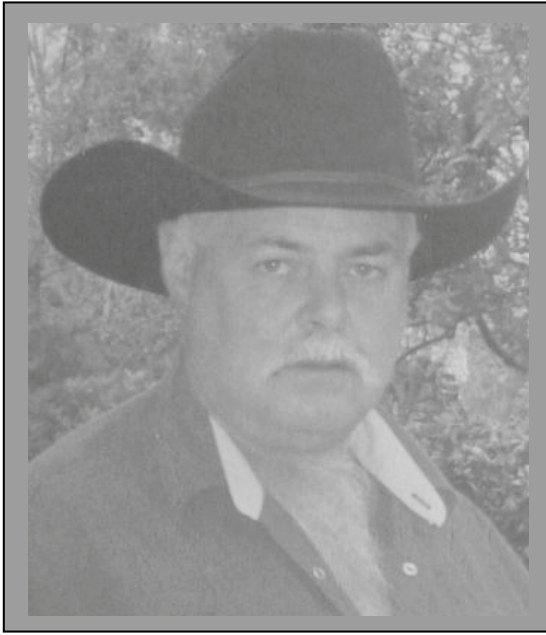

DIRECTOR'S PROFILE

Bob Armitage -

N.R.A. Executive Director

My life has been an awesome adventure and I have been fortunate to travel to many countries, do some amazing things and experience more in my life than most people could only dream about.

I was born in Tiahape New Zealand and I am a second generation cowboy. School was not one of my strong points and at an early age I was out in the work force. Coming from a rural back ground I soon become adapted to a variety of employment tasks from truck driving, to shearing sheep and working in meatworks. I started competing in Bull riding and Steer Wrestling events and won a little Bull riding but my true passion was Steer Wrestling. I made the NZ finals a number of times

1977 the USA was on the "to do" list, so I was off to the bright lights. My partner in crime Nigel Westlake was dragging the chain so I booked a ticket and headed off on my own. I was really organised when I hopped off the plane in LA, looked around and thought "Wow! This is great! What next?" I had no contacts to call and knew nobody. Just at that point, I ran into a girl I had grown up with as a kid. She had married an American and was at the airport to meet her dad. I was off to a good start!

It was not long and I was on the ground running! I started working for a stock contractor in California and my travelling partner finally showed up. For the next 12 months we travelled over a large part of the USA and Canada working, rodeoing and having a bunch of fun. After 12 months Nigel travelled on to England but I decided to stay in North America. I spent the next 2 years moving between Canada, the USA and Mexico. I was fortunate to see some amazing country, meet some amazing people and experience some amazing things from driving trucks up the Alaska highway and out to the top of the Ross river pipe line to pick up hunters guide horses, crossing rivers perched on a barge with ice coming off the glaciers and being told "you better be back in 2 days or the truck stays in until the river freezes and the they turn the frozen river into a road".

I then spent a winter and spring working on the A7 ranch in the Rocky Mountains in Alberta. This was an amazing part of my trip. I made the mistake of moving their dozer that was in the machinery shed so I could work on other tractors, and they soon realised I was a dozer operator. I spent the next 6 weeks, 4 hours a day, pushing snow with an open cab D7 in sub zero conditions so they could feed hay out to the cattle. Come spring it was all worth it. Every day we rode around the most beautiful country you could ever imagine, checking the cows and calves, plus seeing a mother bear with 2 cubs playing in the bush, it was a bonus to see them every day.

My visa was running out so the USA was on call, so I was Texas bound. I spent the summer working and rodeoing out of a small town 100 miles from El Paso in the salt bush country below the Carlsbad Caverns. It was a complete change going from the Rockies to the desert! I got to meet a bunch of the Mexicans working in the area and this opened the door for me to spend some time in Mexico.

After this, my sister was getting married so I was NZ bound. I spent the next few years rodeoing and working the summer in NZ and the winter in Australia doing what I enjoyed most, traveling and rodeoing. At this point I met up with Debbie who persevered, worked, travelled and followed me around the rodeos in NZ and Australia.

While in NZ, I was approached by the NZ film commission to work on a NZ production about rodeo. We spent nearly a month working on that movie and they had cowboys from Australia, USA, Canada and NZ featuring in it. It is well worth an entertaining hour so Google 'Hunchin down the track'. You can then say you have witnessed deer being wrestled from a helicopter!

Back in Australia with no money but a lot of amazing memories, Debbie and I got married and we decided that it might be time for a reality check and start to make something a bit more substantial, so I applied for a job as a log truck driver for a tree lopping company. I was employed by the most amazing Aboriginal guy "Wally." We had a lot of fun and he taught me so much. We started to contract out on some big projects and finished up cutting the majority of the timber for the new Brisbane Airport. We worked there for nearly 2 years and from there, Graham Clarke and myself cut a big part of the timber for the Wivenhoe dam. From this job we moved straight into the Hinze dam project. **(Continued.....)**

DIRECTOR'S PROFILE – Bob Armitage Continued.....

I took on a contract to supply pit props for the underground mines. This risk turned out to be a disaster and we were back to square one with no money and no work and we were totally gutted. Debbie was amazing and we all went back to work at the meat works trying to pay off some of our debt. Then out of the blue my old Aboriginal mate "Wally" showed up and yep we were back in business.

In 1985 came the power strike and all the contracts were being let out to private contractors. My mate Wally had more front than Ben Hur and got us into the system and started to do some work for Energex. It was pretty scary stuff, because to fund this work, we had to borrow big heaps of money and Wally then got scared so I was on my own. Doing the work was the easy part, but having very little schooling was proving to be a hassle. So I learnt very quickly that I needed to employ people with skills that were way out of my comfort zone! From small beginnings, we built up a number of companies to become one the largest tree companies in Australia, with jobs covering the whole east coast of Australia. This made us the largest private owners of Vermeer tree equipment in the Southern Hemisphere. Over time, I have sold some businesses and I have been fortunate in being able to sell most of them out at the right time.

Rodeo has been a huge part of my family's life and has been a terrific sport for us all. Debbie, Shandelle and Steven have all been successful competitors and it has allowed us to travel and compete all over Australia, New Zealand, Canada and the USA. I am also a life member of the National Rodeo Association. I had the opportunity to help put together the National student Rodeo Association which is affiliated to the largest youth rodeo association in the world, the National High School Rodeo Association. The benefits rodeo in Australia will get from this association are enormous! Already we have champions on a world level who have benefited from being involved in the High School program. I believe my lifetime involvement in the sport of rodeo and my success in the business world will be a great asset in helping guide the NRA into an exciting new chapter.

Australian Rodeo Federation Update

The second meeting of the Australian Rodeo Federation took place on Tuesday 21 May 2013 at the Australian Rodeo Heritage Centre in Warwick, Queensland. Jason Hall and Bob Armitage attended on behalf of the NRA along with representatives from the Australian Professional Rodeo Association (APRA), Australian Bushman's Campdraft & Rodeo Association (ABCRA), Central Rodeo Cowboys Association (CRCRA), Professional Bull Riders (PBR), Queensland Rodeo Association (QRA), Rodeo Services Association (RSA) and Australasian Team Roping Association (ATRA).

Significant time at the meeting was dedicated to producing the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between all parties. The MOA identifies the objectives of the Australian Rodeo Federation as follows.

1. To establish the Code of Conduct for the care and treatment of rodeo livestock.
2. To establish disciplinary procedures and penalties as they relate to the Code of Conduct.
3. To govern the sport of rodeo so far as governance relates to the Code of Conduct or such other activities as the parties determine from time to time.
4. To ensure where there is a conflict between the rules of competition and the Code of Conduct for the care and treatment of livestock the later shall prevail over the rules of competition.

The key outcomes from the meeting were as follows.

- Agreement that the Executive Committee would consist of 2 representatives from each of the APRA and ABCRA and one representative from each of the NRA, CRCRA, PBR, QRA, RSA and ATRA.
- Agreement that an invitation would be extended to the National Rodeo Council of Australia (NRCA) to have one representative on the Executive Committee.
- Greg Frewin (ABCRA) was elected as Chairman.
- Glen Mansfield (APRA) was elected as Secretary/Treasurer.
- Jason Hall (NRA) and Steve Hannan (ATRA) were elected as additional signatories.

The overall cooperation between all parties at the meeting was outstanding and all agreed that we took another giant step forward in the pursuit of being officially recognised as a sport by Government. A letter will be sent to all committee shortly with some more information on the ARF and a request to supply some data to assist the ARF with discussion with the government.

Further updates will be provided to all members following the next meeting.

NRA RULE BOOK CHANGES

as of 1st January 2013

Below are some of the rules to be updated in our new rule book currently awaiting printing.

- 1) Breakaway Roping
 - a. To increase the number of strings used to 4 (four) pieces.
- 2) Time Event Contractors
 - a. Steer Wrestling stock
 - i. Steer Wrestling Cattle horns shall be a minimum 225mm on both horns. The measurement will be from the base of the horn to the tip of the horn. The horn spread of cattle shall be no more than 750mm from Tip to Tip unless approved by the Event Director. Stock Contractors are expected to co-operate in trimming cattle's horns to allow them to freely pass through the Time Event Box.
 - ii. The above rules also applies to Steer Undecorating Stock (where cattle have horns)
- 3) Rope & Tie
 - a. It is mandatory for Rope & Tie competitors to use the devise for the event.
- 4) Junior Members
 - a. Junior Members must be 17yrs and under as of the 1st of January.
- 5) The final decision on cancelling a rodeo or stopping a rodeo due to weather or ground condition must be done by NRA Directors.
- 6) Affiliated Committees:
 - a. Judges, Time Keepers and Chute Boss are to be appointed from the NRA approved official list published in the monthly NRA Newsletter.
 - b. All NRA approved rodeos must have two (2) NRA approved Judges and one (1) NRA approved timekeeper for Points Award/Bull Ride rodeo and two (2) NRA approved timekeepers for All Round Rodeo and one (1) NRA approved Chute Boss.
- 7) All rules apply to the parents and/or guardians of junior competitors and they are therefore subject to the same disciplinary action.

For all Time Events

To be able to get in the box to push is optional, if needed for all time events. However, the person in the box must not leave the box, cannot touch the stocks tail or pull on the ear. Immediate fine will be issued.

This was approved by the Board of Directors on the 16th Feb 2013 Board meeting.

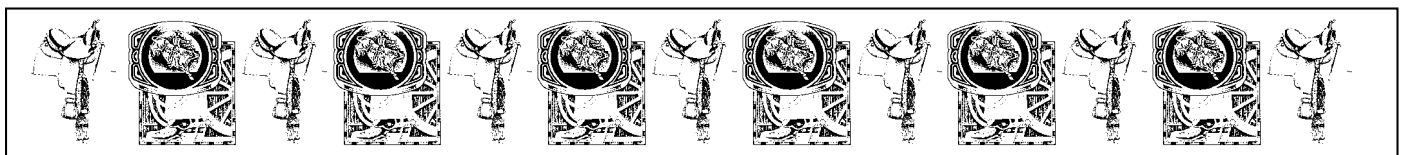
