NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

Campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a Property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

COMMITTEES:

Committees – Please do not hesitate to contact the NRA Office if you require any assistance with the organisation of your rodeo.

The NRA Office are readily available to help you with obtaining your arena officials, planning of your events and program, and any other queries you may have to make your rodeo run as smoothly as possible with less work for your committee.

If you have any issues relating to Public Liability Insurance or your rodeo promotion, please don't hesitate to contact the NRA office as we will only be too happy to assist you.

ROOKIE AND NOVICE

Rookie Competition:

- A Rookie is a member in their first or second year of Rodeo.
- A Rookie Title can be won in their first or second year of membership.
- Points are accrued from Open Competition Only. (Rookie points are recorded in the Open Standings in the newsletter with an *R* beside the competitor's name).
- A Rookie is eligible for Novice Money until they "Break Open".

Rookie Breaks Open

1. Wins a title
 2. Accrues 1000 Novice points in an event
 3. Completes second year of membership
- (In all of the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only.)

ALL ROOKIE COMPETITORS MUST ADVISE THE OFFICE IN WRITING OF THEIR ROOKIE STATUS

Novice Competition:

- A Novice competitor is a member competing in an event not competed in by said member and has been a financial member of NRA for at least two years.
- A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points and Novice Money until they break open and become an open member. (Novice Points do not appear in the standings in the Newsletter. All enquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the NRA Office)

Breaking Open:

As a competitor "Breaks Open" they will be notified in writing from the Office and recorded in the "Break Open" Register. The Competitors who have "Broken Open" will be published in the monthly Newsletter. These competitors are no longer classed as a Novice Competitor and they are also no longer eligible for Novice money or points. However your Rookie (*R*) status will remain in the standings until the end of the Rodeo Season.

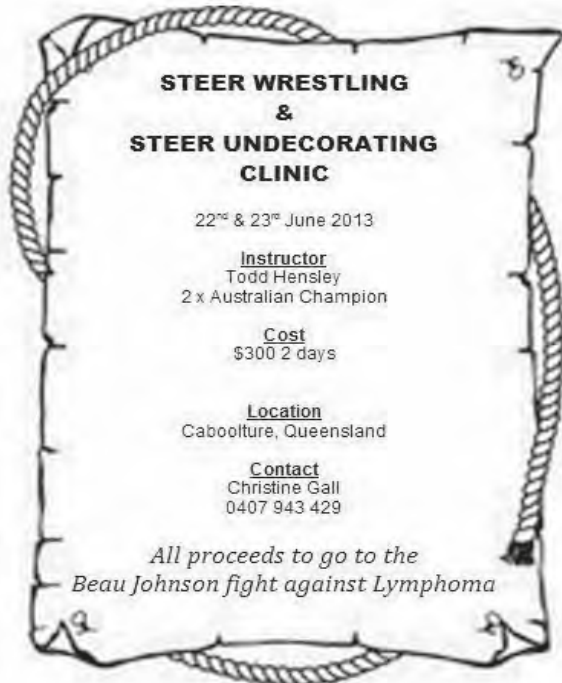

IMPORTANT RULES

All Juniors (including Day Members) must have suitable proof of age available on the day, should there be a need for verification.

Junior Competitors who compete in any Junior and or Open Rodeo Events:

- **TIME EVENT JUNIOR COMPETITORS:**
Must wear properly fitted AUSTRALIAN APPROVED HELMET with chin straps fastened at all times during the ride
- **ROUGH STOCK JUNIOR COMPETITORS:**
Must wear properly fitted FULL FACE PROTECTIVE HELMET WITH CHIN STRAP FASTENED UP AT ALL TIMES during the ride
Your helmet must be appropriately adjusted to fit you and chin straps fastened up before you ride. Chute Boss and or Officials may request to inspect the helmet.
- ***Approved properly fitted protective VEST. If this request is not met, you will not be granted the ride and your stock will be turned out.***
- These rules include All Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.
- If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you Must STILL ABIDE BY THE Junior rules when competing in Junior events*.
- Juniors competing in OPEN EVENTS MUST HAVE AN UPGRADED Open Membership as Junior membership only entitles you to compete in Junior events.
- If you wish to compete in an Open event you must UPGRADE your membership to Open Membership: Other Men's and Ladies' Open Membership of \$110.00 (from \$44.00 to \$154.00) and plus bond of \$60.00 (from \$15.00 to \$75.00).
- ***NOTE:** If there is not a Junior event the same as the event you wish to compete in, you may compete in the Open event by paying Open day membership. However, with option you are not entitled to receive points, only prize money.

In memory of Tony

Tony Breed was born in England on the 28th November 1936.

In his younger days he did Weight Lifting, boxing and he played the piano. He would accompany his mother while she sang opera.

Tony was a corporal in the Army in England. He also worked as a plasterer, a brick layer and a tiler in both England and Australia.

He met Val in England. Tony moved over to Australia with his parents in 1960. Six months later Val followed and they were married on 7th October 1961. They have five daughters.

Tony started doing rodeos in the mid 60's. I met Tony in the early 70's. He helped me to learn Calf Roping and Steer Wrestling. He was still riding Broncs at the time. We used to have a lot of practice sessions at his property in Cockatoo. He was a gracious host and always put on a pretty mean BBQ for everyone. He was always teaching and helping other people, and he was still doing that till the end.

Four of his daughters also did rodeoing. They were riding and breaking-in their own horses from a very young age.

Tony won several Southern Cross Awards and he made the finals in the NFR on several occasions.

One of the other people Tony helped was Simone Olman (Schultz) who went on to win the Breakaway Roping Title of the NRA.

Tony and Val separated in the mid 80's. He later met Tina and they have been together ever since.

In 2004 Tony and Tina moved to Queensland to live. Tony made the NRA finals in Team Roping several times. We used to practice at Murray Whitwell's property. Tony also practiced at Bob Armitage and he roped with him at rodeos. Tony passed away in Victoria on Thursday 28th March 2013 after a short illness.

He will be sadly missed by all.

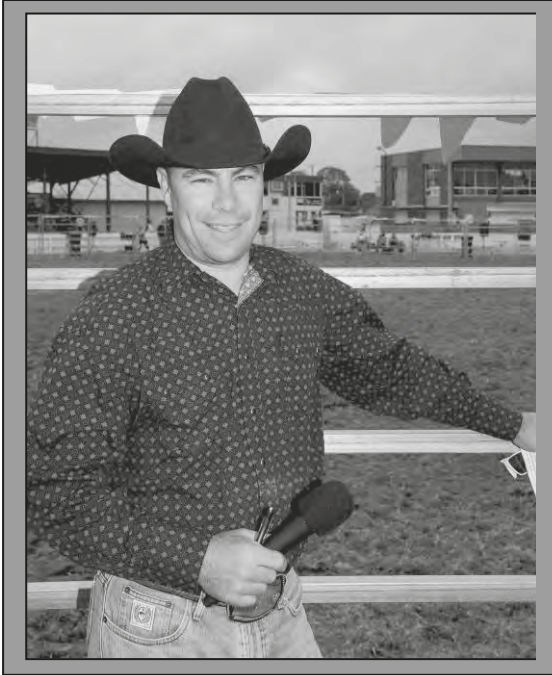

DIRECTOR'S PROFILE

Jason Hall -

N.R.A. Executive Director

Jason Hall was born into the sport of rodeo with his father Kerry a successful competitor, stock contractor and rodeo promoter. Jason started his rodeo career in the Poddy Ride and was runner-up Junior Champion in 1984. He also competed in his first open event, the Open Bull Ride, at the Dalby Rodeo of that year as a 15 year old.

After taking a few years off rodeo in the late 80's and early 90's to attend university and play rugby league, Jason recommenced his rodeo career in the Bull Ride and the Bareback Ride events. After qualifying for the National Finals on a number of occasions, the highlight of his career came in 1999 when he was crowned the Bareback Champion of the National Rodeo Association Finals Series. He followed this up by finishing Runner-up Bareback Champion in the 2000 rodeo season. With a young family to care for Jason retired from the rough stock events at the end of the 2000 rodeo season and now competes solely in the Steer Wrestling event.

A third generation of Hall's are also starting to leave their mark on the rodeo scene with Jason's third son Clay being crowned Poddy Ride Champion in 2011 and his youngest son, Zane, one of the leading Poddy Riders this season.

As well as being involved as a competitor in the sport of rodeo, Jason is also one of the leading Rodeo Announcers in the country, a stock contractor and has been successful rodeo promoter. Along with Steve Doneathy, Jason has been conducting the first round of the NRA Finals Series at Brothers Leagues Club in Ipswich since 1997.

Outside of rodeo, Jason is the General Manager Engineering Standards & Technology at Ergon Energy, a government owned corporation responsible for the distribution of electricity across 97% of Queensland. He has an Honours Degree in Electrical & Computer Engineering from Queensland University of Technology and a Graduate Certificate in Management from Deakin University. He is also a trade qualified electrical fitter mechanic and has more than 25 years experience in the Queensland Electricity Supply Industry.

Jason is married to Kristie and they have four boys; Ryan (17), Wade (15), Clay (13) and Zane (11).

BURNIN' DOWN THE HOUSE

RAIN once again led to the postponement of events this competition month however a number of events were successfully held with competitors keen to take part.

The Mallanganee Village Festival bull ride was the first on March 23 with an open, novice and junior bull ride as well as junior steer ride and poddy ride making up the program.

John Foster took home a majority share of the prize money by winning the open bull ride with an 80 point ride as well as taking out third place in the novice bull ride.

In the open bull ride placings Foster was followed by Jeffrey Morretto and Thomas Bruggy while ahead of Foster in the novice bull ride was Jackson Felton in first place followed by Matt Goodwin.

Ethan McConnell took out the junior bull ride while Jarvis Sawtell and Lane Heaton shared poll position in the junior steer ride with Dan Ruhland the only qualified time in the poddy ride.

The annual Gympie Bull and Bronc was also held on March 23 after being postponed from its usual February slot due to rain.

Matthew Carlo put on a class display of open bull riding to be scored 82 points for the win with Thomas Bruggy, Charlie Scott and Reece Weller filling the places.

In the saddle bronc ride Jack Capewell led them in followed by Cameron Taylor, Michael Maher and Joel Hill while in the bareback it was Clinton Burton for the win just ahead of home town cowboy Matthew Makinson, Richard Peterkin and Ian Niemann.

The barrel racers were challenged by slippery ground on the night with Skye Evans taking home first place followed by Tara Warburton, Jacki Blucher and Danika Boland.

There were just two scores in the junior bull ride with PJ Bradford taking out first place and Callum Miller second with no scores in the poddy ride for the night.

Easter weekend saw competitors travel to Brymaroo where Matthew Young was the only scorer in the bull ride taking home over \$1200 in prize money.

However the saddle bronc riders shared the prize money four ways with Joel Hill first followed by Jim Ryan, Mark Collins and Cody Kettleton.

In the bareback it was a tie for first between Matty Makinson and Ian Niemann followed by Dinny Moran in third place and Steele Allston in fourth.

The open barrel racers were led in by junior competitor Kylie Siebenhausen followed by Hilary Thrift, Luran Bostock and Katie Vaughan.

In the novice bull ride three competitors rode time with PJ Bradford taking first followed by Keelan Alexander and Matthew Young.

In the junior events PJ Bradford took out the bull ride, Shanae Payne the barrel race, Clay Hall the junior steer ride and Lachlan Dark the poddy ride.

At the Maidenwell Hotel bull ride Reece Weller took out the open bull ride while PJ Bradford won the novice bull ride, Bailey Schultz the junior bull ride and Jeffery Clements the poddy ride.

The Rosewood Community Rodeo had strong nominations with Brodie Bean winning the open bull ride, Michael Maher the saddle bronc, Clinton Burton the bareback and Maddison Swan the open barrel race.

Meantime in the junior events Skye Evans won the barrel race Beau Creighton the steer ride and Blake Weier the poddy ride.

The Oakey bulls, broncs and barrels kicked off April with PJ Bradford once again making his mark this time by being the only scorer in both the open and novice bull ride events. Mark Collins was a few points ahead of the rest to win the saddle bronc while Clinton Burton once again showed good form to win the bareback. In the barrel race Luran Bostock went home smiling as did place getters Maddison Swan, Tamasin Joe Kong and Emmalene Deaves.

IN MEMORY OF

MICHAEL JAMES HECKSHER

(31.12.1960 - 16.6.2011)

Mick Hecksher partner to Judy Gough for 20 years, lost his battle with melanoma cancer on June 16, 2011. He was first diagnosed with the disease in 2002 when a small black freckle was removed from his back. In 2006 a lump was found on the back of his left shoulder, again the lump was removed and Mick was told he had an 80% chance of the melanoma coming back. In 2010 it came back. By the time it was noticed, the melanoma had spread through Micks body. It was in his bowel, stomach and brain. Mick was scheduled to undertake treatment for his condition, but on the day he arrived at the P.A. Hospital, he was rushed into immediate surgery to have a large melanoma tumour removed from his stomach, without operating that night Mick would have died.

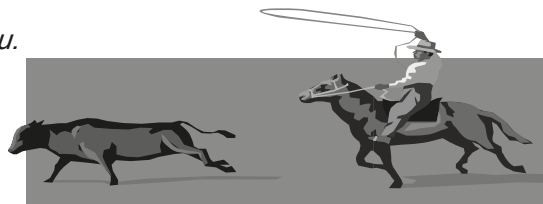
He managed to live for another 6 months. From the time that Mick learnt of his condition he had to fight for what little time he had left. No treatment – chemotherapy or radiation made any difference to this horrible disease. Trials were not an option. If you have melanoma in your brain, you do not qualify for any trial treatment.

Doctors were amazed that Mick had lived for 6 months. It was because he was a very fit and healthy man when he contracted the melanoma. His fitness was all that got Mick through the 6 months.

To be by someone's side when they are suffering from cancer, to watch them slip away is the most horrendous heart wrenching experience you could ever imagine. This is why Judy has now decided to hold this memorial in her partners honour, to help raise money for much needed funds to help discover a way to maybe one day eliminate this horrible disease.

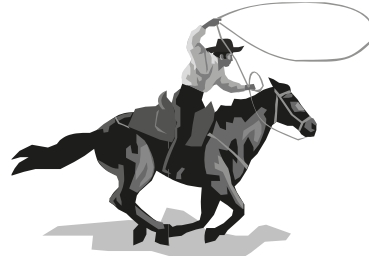

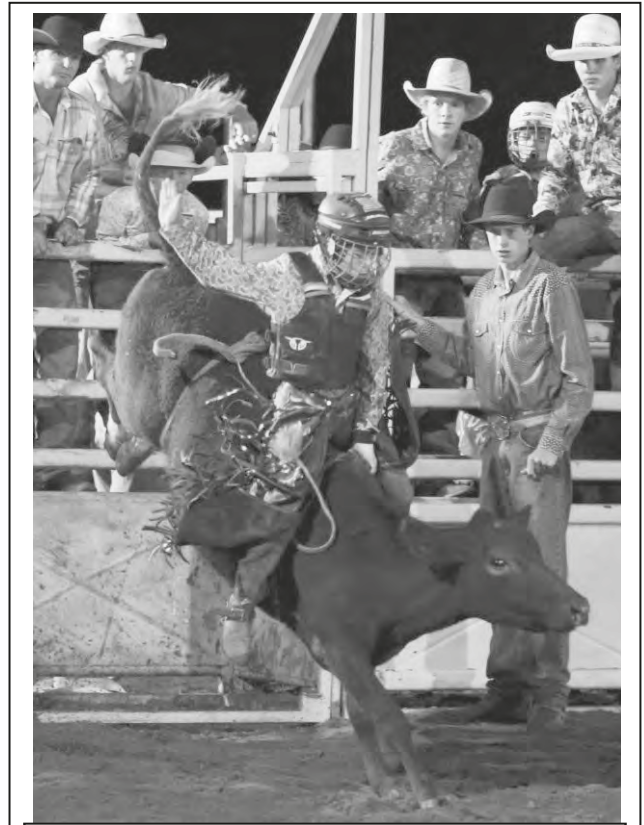
