NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

Campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a Property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

COMMITTEES

Please do not hesitate to contact the NRA Office if you require any assistance with the organisation of your rodeo.

The NRA Office are readily available to help you with obtaining your arena officials, planning of your events and program, and any other queries you may have to make your rodeo run as smoothly as possible with less work for your committee.

If you have any issues relating to Public Liability Insurance or your rodeo promotion, please don't hesitate to contact the NRA office as we will only be too happy to assist you.

NRA RODEO CATEGORIES

ALL ROUND CHAMPIONSHIP RODEO

- Must include a minimum of all 7 Standard Events with a minimum prize money of \$500 per event
- Full points are awarded for individual titles and All Round titles

POINTS AWARD RODEO

- Must include a minimum of 3 Standard Events with minimum prize money of \$500 per event
- Half points are awarded for individual titles only

BULL RIDE

- Must include a minimum of a Bull Ride, Novice Bull Ride and Junior Bull with minimum prize money of \$1500, \$350 and \$200 respectively.
- Half points are awarded to individual event titles only

JUNIOR RODEO

- Must include the following events
Under 8 – Barrel Race and Dummy Roping
Under 12 – Barrel Race, Dummy Roping, Breakaway Roping, Pole Bending and Poddy Ride
Under 16 – Barrel Race, Pole Bending, Calf Tying, Breakaway Roping and Boys Steer Ride
Under 18 – Bull Ride, Saddle Ride, Bareback Ride, Chute Dogging, Team Roping, Rope & Tie, Barrel Race and Breakaway Roping
- Age as of 1 January
- Points are awarded to Junior Rodeo Series only and are not awarded to individual event titles

Hardest thing you had to learn?

The hardest thing that I had to learn is that not every rodeo is going to be the best run, and that there is always room to improve on yourself and your horses.

Where are some of the rodeos you have participated in?

I have competed in Rodeos all over Southeast Queensland and NSW.

How long have you been riding? 13 years

How old were you when you started riding?

I was 2 years old when I started competing in Rodeos and Pony Club.

Have you competed overseas or been to any international events?

No, but I have qualified 3 times to compete at the NBHA World Youth Finals and the NSRA Finals in America.

IMPORTANT RULES

All Juniors (including Day Members) must have suitable proof of age available on the day, should there be a need for verification.

Junior Competitors who compete in any Junior and or Open Rodeo Events:

▪ **TIME EVENT JUNIOR COMPETITORS:**
Must wear properly fitted AUSTRALIAN APPROVED HELMET with chin straps fastened at all times during the ride

▪ **ROUGH STOCK JUNIOR COMPETITORS:**
Must wear properly fitted FULL FACE PROTECTIVE HELMET WITH CHIN STRAP FASTENED UP AT ALL TIMES during the ride

Your helmet must be appropriately adjusted to fit you and chin straps fastened up before you ride. Chute Boss and or Officials may request to inspect the helmet.

▪ **Approved properly fitted protective VEST. If this request is not met, you will not be granted the ride and your stock will be turned out.**

▪ These rules include All Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.

▪ If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you Must STILL ABIDE BY THE Junior rules when competing in Junior events.

▪ Juniors competing in OPEN EVENTS MUST HAVE AN UPGRADED Open Membership as Junior membership only entitles you to compete in Junior events.

▪ If you wish to compete in an Open event you must UPGRADE your membership to Open Membership: Other Men's and Ladies'

Open Membership of \$110.00 (from \$44.00 to \$154.00) and plus bond of \$60.00 (from \$15.00 to \$75.00).

▪ **NOTE:** If there is not a Junior event the same as the event you wish to compete in, you may compete in the Open event by paying Open day membership. However, with option you are not entitled to receive points, only prize money.

NOTES FROM THE OFFICE

All Round Rodeo Revival

It is extremely pleasing to see the number of new All Round Rodeos on our NRA calendar. Lowood, QSEC, Woodford and Boonah have all affiliated this year and we already have confirmation of both Stanthorpe and Brymaroo returning in 2014. There are a number of reasons for this increase in All Round Rodeos but the most pleasing aspect has been that, in the majority of cases, one or more of our members have joined committees and are assisting in the revival. This kind of proactive behaviour will ensure that our Association can continue to grow and improve this great sport of rodeo.

The Lowood Show Society kicked off the revival on the 24th August after they were rained out on their original date on the 9th March. With Gene Hingst assisting the committee, the rodeo was a great success with over 350 competitors on the day. The committee have confirmed that the rodeo will return again in 2014 and are in the process of locking in the affiliation.

The Queensland State Equestrian Centre (QSEC) joined the NRA calendar back in 2011 with their Urban Country Rodeo however they added an additional event this year with the recently completed Inner Circle Rum Rodeo on 22nd September. This magnificent venue is a pleasure to attend for both the spectators and the competitors and a lot of credit must go to Bill Urquhart, Dale Frahm and Doc Cavanagh for the work they did in helping to make this venue a reality. We look forward to continuing our great relationship with the QSEC management team.

With a large number of our members based around the Woodford area, Steve Doneathy decided it was time for some positive action and joined the Woodford Show Society. He has been integral in leading this hard working committee to return the Woodford Rodeo to the NRA calendar. The rodeo will be held on Saturday 19th October.

The final coup this year has seen Kerry Hall and Carol Bostock work with the Boonah Campdraft and Rodeo Committee to transform their Points Award rodeo to Round 1 of the NRA National Finals Rodeo Series on 16th November. With Boonah being one of the original committees to join the SEQRRA (now the NRA) back in 1966 it is only fitting that this rodeo return to be one of the venues for this year's Finals. It is hoped that this rodeo can be locked in as a permanent home for the National Finals Rodeo for years to come. It should also be noted that this year's National Finals Rodeo Series will see each of the three rounds run every event that an end of year title is awarded to including all of the junior events. This is seen as a massive step forward in ensuring that our entire membership base is catered for at the Finals.

The 2014 season is still a little way off but we can already confirm that the Stanthorpe Rodeo will return to the NRA calendar on 8th March. Stanthorpe newcomers Darren Doughty and Kylie Mochrie (pictured below) made it their mission to resurrect this iconic rodeo when they moved to Stanthorpe a year ago. The revival of the rodeo has been assisted by a \$30,000 grant from the Queensland Government Gambling Community Benefit Fund which has seen a number of improvements to the grounds that will ensure a fantastic event in conjunction with the Apple & Grape Harvest Festival.

Long-time NRA member, David Wood, has worked tirelessly over the past few years with the Brymaroo Campdraft and Rodeo Committee to build the Brymaroo Rodeo back up to its former glory. After starting out with just a Bull Ride a number of years ago, 2014 will see Brymaroo once again conduct an All Round Rodeo on Easter Saturday, 19th April.

We have also had a number of other committees contact us to conduct their first ever All Round Rodeo and details of these rodeos will be released over the coming months as affiliations are locked in. If you are interested in conducting an All Round Rodeo and would like some more details please contact the NRA Office for an information pack.

ROOKIE AND NOVICE

Rookie Competition:

- A Rookie is a member in their first or second year of Rodeo.
- A Rookie Title can be won in their first or second year of membership.
- Points are accrued from Open Competition Only. (Rookie points are recorded in the Open Standings in the newsletter with an *R* beside the competitor's name).
- A Rookie is eligible for Novice Money until they "Break Open".

Rookie Breaks Open

1. Wins a title
 2. Accrues 1000 Novice points in an event
 3. Completes second year of membership
- (In all of the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only.)

ALL ROOKIE COMPETITORS MUST ADVISE THE OFFICE IN WRITING OF THEIR ROOKIE STATUS

Novice Competition:

- A Novice competitor is a member competing in an event not competed in by said member and has been a financial member of NRA for at least two years.
- A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points and Novice Money until they break open and become an open member. (Novice Points do not appear in the standings in the Newsletter. All enquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the NRA Office)

Breaking Open:

As a competitor "Breaks Open" they will be notified in writing from the Office and recorded in the "Break Open" Register. The Competitors who have "Broken Open" will be published in the monthly Newsletter. These competitors are no longer classed as a Novice Competitor and they are also no longer eligible for Novice money or points. However your Rookie (*R*) status will remain in the standings until the end of the Rodeo Season.
