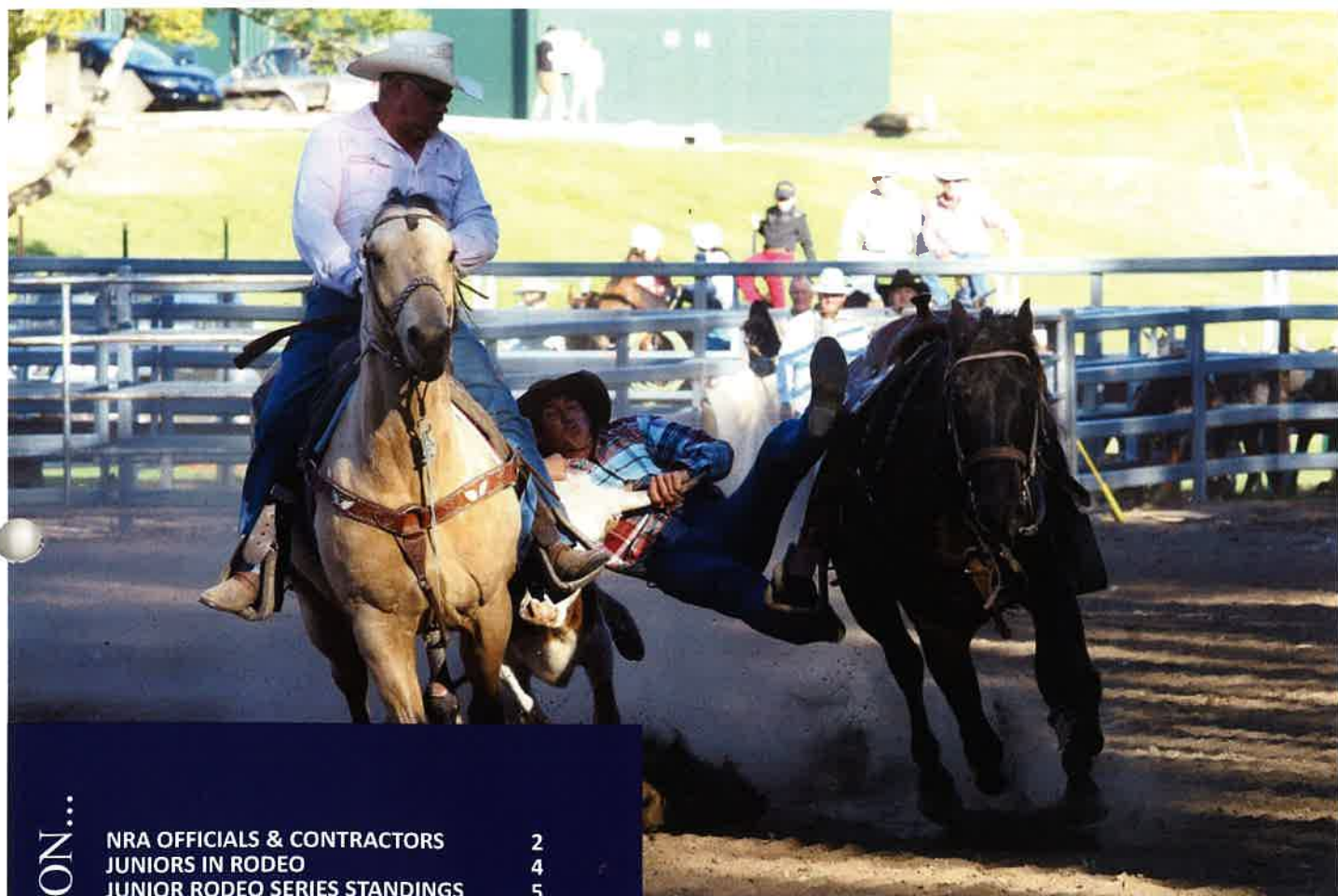

NRA RODEO CATEGORIES

ALL ROUND CHAMPIONSHIP RODEO

- Must include a minimum of all 7 Standard Events with a minimum prize money of \$500 per event
- Full points are awarded for individual titles and All Round titles

POINTS AWARD RODEO

- Must include a minimum of 3 Standard Events with minimum prize money of \$500 per event
- Half points are awarded for individual titles only

BULL RIDE

- Must include a minimum of a Bull Ride, Novice Bull Ride and Junior Bull with minimum prize money of \$1500, \$350 and \$200 respectively.
- Half points are awarded to individual event titles only

JUNIOR RODEO

- Must include the following events
7 Years and Under – Barrel Race and Dummy Roping
11 Years and Under – Barrel Race, Dummy Roping, Breakaway Roping, Pole Bending and Poddy Ride
12 – 15 Years – Barrel Race, Pole Bending, Calf Tying, Breakaway Roping and Boys Steer Ride
16 – Under 18 Years – Bull Ride, Saddle Ride, Bareback Ride, Chute Dogging, Team Roping, Rope & Tie, Barrel Race and Breakaway Roping
- Points are awarded to Junior Rodeo Series only and are not awarded to individual titles

NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

Campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a Property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

COMMITTEES

Please do not hesitate to contact the NRA Office if you require any assistance with the organisation of your rodeo.

The NRA Office are readily available to help you with obtaining your arena officials, planning of your events and program, and any other queries you may have to make your rodeo run as smoothly as possible with less work for your committee.

IMPORTANT RULES

All Juniors (including Day Members) must have suitable proof of age available on the day, should there be a need for verification.

Junior Competitors who compete in any Junior and or Open Rodeo Events:

- **TIME EVENT JUNIOR COMPETITORS:**
Must wear properly fitted AUSTRALIAN APPROVED HELMET with chin straps fastened at all times during the ride
- **ROUGH STOCK JUNIOR COMPETITORS:**
Must wear properly fitted FULL FACE PROTECTIVE HELMET WITH CHIN STRAP FASTENED UP AT ALL TIMES during the ride
Your helmet must be appropriately adjusted to fit you and chin straps fastened up before you ride. Chute Boss and or Officials may request to inspect the helmet.
- Approved properly fitted protective VEST. If this request is not met, you will not be granted the ride and your stock will be turned out.
- These rules include All Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.
- If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you Must STILL ABIDE BY THE Junior rules when competing in Junior events*.
- Juniors competing in OPEN EVENTS MUST HAVE AN UPGRADED Open Membership as Junior membership only entitles you to compete in Junior events.
- If you wish to compete in an Open event you must UPGRADE your membership to Open Membership: Other Men's and Ladies' Open Membership of \$110.00 (from \$44.00 to \$154.00) and plus bond of \$60.00 (from \$15.00 to \$75.00).
- ***NOTE:** If there is not a Junior event the same as the event you wish to compete in, you may compete in the Open event by paying Open day membership. However, with option you are not entitled to receive points, only prize money.

ROOKIE AND NOVICE

Rookie Competition:

- A Rookie is a member in their first or second year of Rodeo.
- A Rookie Title can be won in their first or second year of membership.
- Points are accrued from Open Competition Only. (Rookie points are recorded in the Open Standings in the newsletter with an *R* beside the competitor's name).
- A Rookie is eligible for Novice Money until they "Break Open".

Rookie Breaks Open

1. Wins a title
 2. Accrues 1000 Novice points in an event
 3. Completes second year of membership
- (In all of the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only.)

ALL ROOKIE COMPETITORS MUST ADVISE THE OFFICE IN WRITING OF THEIR ROOKIE STATUS

Novice Competition:

- A Novice competitor is a member competing in an event not competed in by said member and has been a financial member of NRA for at least two years.
- A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points and Novice Money until they break open and become an open member. (Novice Points do not appear in the standings in the Newsletter. All enquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the NRA Office)

Breaking Open:

As a competitor "Breaks Open" they will be notified in writing from the Office and recorded in the "Break Open" Register. The Competitors who have "Broken Open" will be published in the monthly Newsletter. These competitors are no longer classed as a Novice Competitor and they are also no longer eligible for Novice money or points. However your Rookie (*R*) status will remain in the standings until the end of the Rodeo Season.

All Competitors must enter via Gate 14, Old Gympie Road and be allocated parking by the parking warden. Other entrance gates will be restricted to the paying public.

Stable and Camping will be available on site and access is from Gate 14, Old Gympie Road. Costs for Stable per day \$22.00 (3.6m x 3.6m), Stable cleaning bond \$50.00 per stable (refundable on approval from QSEC during the following week) Powered campsite \$20.00 per night, Unpowered campsite \$15.00 per night. Booking for Stable and Camping to be done together when nominating, and paid with rodeo entries.

STRICTLY NO ELECTRIC FENCES TO BE USED.

Compulsory arm bands for competitors only will be issued by the N.R.A. Central Entries Staff on the day. Central entries office will be located on the South Western Conner of the complex.

Competitor's families and companions may enter via Old Gympie Road, but will be required to pay entry at the main ticket office at the front of the complex before entering the grand stand.

An area in the grand stand has been allocated behind the bucking chutes for competitors and their families.

THIS WILL BE STRICTLY CONTROLLED BY BOTH SECURITY AND QSEC STAFF.

Queensland State Equestrian Centre (QSEC) - Camping & Stables Rules and Regulations

To ensure your visit is a happy one, please observe the following rules:

CAMPING RULES

CAMP SITE DETAILS

All personal belongings should be kept within your designated site area so paths and roads are not obstructed. Pegs for tents and annexes are to be no longer than 30cm to avoid damage to pipes etc.

USE OF QSEC WATER

In our commitment to conserve water, washing of vehicles, caravans and campervans is not permitted. Basic washing of the inside of floats and trucks is permitted. See reception if you require a hose.

LOSS OF PERSONAL BELONGINGS

QSEC and MBRC shall not be liable for any loss or damage to your property by theft or personal injury.

NOISE

No excessive noise i.e. loud radios or generators are permitted before 7am or after 9pm.

USE OF CAMPING FACILITIES

In the interest of safety, please ensure that any children are accompanied by an adult to the amenities. All visitors are asked to keep toilet, shower and laundry facilities as clean and tidy as possible. Please turn taps off and do not put articles likely to cause obstructions into basins, sinks or toilets. Please keep out of the wooded area - this is a protected habitat.

SPEED LIMIT

Please observe a maximum 10kph speed limit at all times.

RUBBISH

All refuse is to be wrapped firmly and placed in one of the many appropriately marked rubbish bins provided. Rubbish bins are not to be removed from the designated areas.

DUMPING OF SULLAGE/GREY WATER

Patrons must not dump their sullage in the campgrounds or protected habitats. Patrons must contain their sullage/grey water and find an appropriate dump point once they have left the campgrounds.

STABLE RULES

STABLE CONDUCT

- You must comply with the instructions of all QSEC staff, volunteers and signage displayed.
- The use of fire hoses is not permitted except in the case of an emergency.
- Please ensure enclosed footwear is worn at all times within the stable blocks.
- All aisles must be kept clear of all obstructions in case of an emergency.
- No riding is permitted in stable aisles or stalls.
- Horses should be cared for according to best accepted practice.
- Do not leave horses unattended unless within a stable.

DOGS

Dogs are permitted in QSEC camping grounds provided they are kept on a lead (maximum length of 1 metre) and under control at all times. Dogs must be kept away from horse activities including the Main Arena and shower/toilet/laundry facilities. Any person not adhering to this guideline will be asked to leave the grounds immediately and no refund given. Please ensure that dog droppings are disposed of using the bags provided.

FIRES & DIGGING OF HOLES

The lighting of fires at sites and digging of holes is strictly prohibited.

SMOKING

Smoking is only permitted in the designated areas.

GLASS & ALCOHOL

No glass is permitted on the QSEC grounds. CANS AND PLASTIC BOTTLES ONLY. No BYO alcohol is permitted to be taken into the Main Arena as this is a licensed venue.

ELECTRICITY

For your safety only power cords and terminals with a maximum length of 10 metres are allowed. Please see reception if you require a 15amp/10amp adaptor. **An approved circuit breaker and residual current device are necessary to provide power to sites.**

- Do not leave a horse unattended with a bridle on.
- Do not take a horse out of a stable without a bridle or halter.

AT QSEC WE

- Do not tie horses to trees or fences.
- Stable horses if staying overnight.
- Please use bedding when stabling horses to ensure animal safety and welfare.

ACCIDENTS, INCIDENTS AND DAMAGES

Please report all incidents, accidents and damages to a QSEC staff member or volunteer.

CLEANING STABLES ON DEPARTURE

On departure, please **remove all bedding and manure** from the stable and dispose of the waste into the manure bays provided. Please do not place any foreign material in the manure bays. Ensure that the stable is closed and bolted. The stable will be inspected after your departure and your bond will be refunded to the event organiser if the stable is left in a satisfactory condition i.e. completely clear of all bedding and manure. Please direct any questions regarding your bond refund to your event organiser. **If you have been issued a key, this must be returned prior to your departure otherwise your bond will not be returned.**

A full report of the hottest rodeo action in South East Old.

THE past month of competition kicked off with the Granchester Bull Ride event on the 3rd of August.

Winner of the Open Bull Ride Fraser Babbington collected over \$2000 as the only one to ride time on the night.

Meantime the Novice Bull Ride was won by Matthew Young while brothers Bailey and Taylor Schultz took out first and second in the Junior Bull Ride respectively.

In the Poddy Ride Zane Hall once again stepped forward to show good form.

Also on August 3 was the Pine River Show Rodeo, a point's award event which saw Fraser pick up his second cheque for the day by placing equal second with Joshua Lock in the Open Bull Ride however it was Jeffery Moretto who rode for the win.

In the saddle bronc Jim Ryan and Cameron Taylor split first place on 74 points while on the girls side of the performance junior competitor Kylie Siebenhausen was in fine form taking out first place just over 0.2 ahead of the rest of the field.

The junior events saw no times in the Poddy Ride however Ethan McConnell, Jarvis Sawtell, Ty Thomson and Joshua Lock rounded out the placed in the under-16 Junior Bull Ride.

The following weekend Canungra kicked off a run of three all round rodeos.

At the rough stock end of the arena open event winners for the day were Ryan Dickens in the bull ride, Joel Hill in the saddle bronc and Ashley Clem in the bareback.

Of the time event cowboys it was Brad Cavanagh who had a standout day taking home a win in the rope and tie and second place in the steer wrestling behind Nick Painter.

The team roping saw Lee Shegog and Jason McPhee team up for the win while the breakaway roping was won by Rachelle Carlo with a quick time of 2.458.

It was a good day of barrel racing for Skye Evans who won both the open and junior barrel race.

Cohen Collins won the bareback with the same score.

Campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a Property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

AUSTRALIAN ANIMAL WELFARE STANDARDS & GUIDELINES – ANIMALS AT RODEOS

A review of the animal welfare Model Codes of Practice (MCOP) in 2005 recommended they be converted into Australian Animal Welfare Standards and Guidelines. Animal Health Australia was commissioned by the Australian Government Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry (DAFF) to manage the conversion process. Under the Australian Animal Welfare Strategy (AAWS) and Animal Health Australia (AHA) management, the existing Codes will be re-written in a new format, to incorporate both the national welfare standards and industry guidelines for each species or enterprise (e.g. rodeo).

One of the key objectives of the Australian Animal Welfare Strategy is to facilitate consistency of legislation across states and territories for improved and sustainable animal welfare outcomes. At the present time, only the National Consultative Committee on Animal Welfare (NCCAW) standards for the care and treatment of animals used in

rodeos exist and not all states and organisations have adopted them. A Writing Group consisting of representatives from DAFF, RSPCA and the Australian Rodeo Federation (ARF) have been working on the draft “Australian Animal Welfare Standards & Guidelines – Animals at Rodeos” which is now ready for industry consultation.

This document was reviewed at the latest ARF meeting in Warwick on Monday 2 September and has now been sent to all of our stock contractors for comment. If you have not received a copy of this document and would like to review it please contact the NRA Office. All comments are required to be returned to the NRA Office by Monday 30 September so that they can be collated and returned to the Writing Group prior to the next ARF meeting.
