NRA RODEO CATEGORIES

ALL ROUND CHAMPIONSHIP RODEO

- Must include a minimum of all 7 Standard Events with a minimum prize money of \$500 per event
- Full points are awarded for individual titles and All Round titles

POINTS AWARD RODEO

- Must include a minimum of 3 Standard Events with minimum prize money of \$500 per event
- Half points are awarded for individual titles only

BULL RIDE

- Must include a minimum of a Bull Ride, Novice Bull Ride and Junior Bull with minimum prize money of \$1500, \$350 and \$200 respectively.
- Half points are awarded to individual event titles only

JUNIOR RODEO

- Must include the following events
Under 8 – Barrel Race and Dummy Roping
Under 12 – Barrel Race, Dummy Roping, Breakaway Roping, Pole Bending and Poddy Ride
Under 16 – Barrel Race, Pole Bending, Calf Tying, Breakaway Roping and Boys Steer Ride
Under 18 – Bull Ride, Saddle Ride, Bareback Ride, Chute Dogging, Team Roping, Rope & Tie, Barrel Race, Pole Bending and Breakaway Roping
- Age as of 1 January
- Points are awarded to Junior Rodeo Series only and are not awarded to individual event titles

NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

Campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a Property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

COMMITTEES

Please do not hesitate to contact the NRA Office if you require any assistance with the organisation of your rodeo.

The NRA Office are readily available to help you with obtaining your arena officials, planning of your events and program, and any other queries you may have to make your rodeo run as smoothly as possible with less work for your committee.

If you have any issues relating to Public Liability Insurance or your rodeo promotion, please don't hesitate to contact the NRA office as we will only be too happy to assist you.

IMPORTANT RULES

All Juniors (including Day Members) must have suitable proof of age available on the day, should there be a need for verification.

Junior Competitors who compete in any Junior and or Open Rodeo Events:

- **TIME EVENT JUNIOR COMPETITORS:**
Must wear properly fitted FULL FACE PROTECTIVE HELMET WITH CHIN STRAP FASTENED UP AT ALL TIMES during the ride
- **ROUGH STOCK JUNIOR COMPETITORS:**
Must wear properly fitted FULL FACE PROTECTIVE HELMET WITH CHIN STRAP FASTENED UP AT ALL TIMES during the ride
 Your helmet must be appropriately adjusted to fit you and chin straps fastened up before you ride. Chute Boss and or Officials may request to inspect the helmet.
- Approved properly fitted protective VEST. If this request is not met, you will not be granted the ride and your stock will be turned out.
- These rules include All Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.
- If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you must STILL ABIDE BY THE Junior rules when competing in Junior events.
- Juniors competing in OPEN EVENTS MUST HAVE AN UPGRADED Open Membership as Junior membership only entitles you to compete in Junior events.
- If you wish to compete in an Open event you must UPGRADE your membership to Open Membership: Other Men's and Ladies' Open Membership of \$110.00 (from \$44.00 to \$154.00) and plus bond of \$60.00 (from \$15.00 to \$75.00).
- **NOTE:** If there is not a Junior event the same as the event you wish to compete in, you may compete in the Open event by paying Open day membership. However, with option you are not entitled to receive points, only prize money.

ROOKIE AND NOVICE

Rookie Competition:

- A Rookie is a member in their first or second year of Rodeo.
- A Rookie Title can be won in their first or second year of membership.
- Points are accrued from Open Competition Only. (Rookie points are recorded in the Open Standings in the newsletter with an *R* beside the competitor's name).
- A Rookie is eligible for Novice Money until they "Break Open".

Rookie Breaks Open

1. Wins a title
 2. Accrues 1000 Novice points in an event
 3. Completes second year of membership
- (In all of the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only.)

ALL ROOKIE COMPETITORS MUST ADVISE THE OFFICE IN WRITING OF THEIR ROOKIE STATUS

Novice Competition:

- A Novice competitor is a member competing in an event not competed in by said member and has been a financial member of NRA for at least two years.
- A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points and Novice Money until they break open and become an open member. (Novice Points do not appear in the standings in the Newsletter. All enquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the NRA Office)

Breaking Open:

As a competitor "Breaks Open" they will be notified in writing from the Office and recorded in the "Break Open" Register. The Competitors who have "Broken Open" will be published in the monthly Newsletter. These competitors are no longer classed as a Novice Competitor and they are also no longer eligible for Novice money or points. However your Rookie (*R*) status will remain in the standings until the end of the Rodeo Season.

BURNIN' DOWN THE HOUSE

A full report of the hottest rodeo action in South East Qld.

The National Rodeo Association results covered in this edition start with the Brookfield Show Rodeo which was held on May 16. This event saw David Kennedy take out top honours in the bull ride followed by a three-way-tie between Fraser Babbington, John Foster and Dave Mawhinney. There were no scores in the novice bull ride, while Bailey Schultz won the junior bull ride and Lleyton Brown won the poddy ride.

The Gympie Show Rodeo all around event was on the next day with good nominations received across all events. Here Jack McArthur took out the bull ride while John McNamee won the saddle bronc and Dinny Moran took out the bareback. At the time event end of the arena Mitch Eastwell was once again quick in his pet event, the rope and tie and took out the win while home town cowboy Ian Allen made a 4.990 second run in the steer wrestling to win his event. Lee Dickinson and Steve Augustin teamed up to win the team roping while Katie Vaughan showed her skill in the breakaway roping to win the event with a 2.570 second run. Cheyenne Whitwell took home the win in the open barrel race and took out second place in the junior barrel race, behind Ashleigh Howard. Other juniors to win their events on the day were Lleyton Brown in the poddy ride and Steele Gilliland in the under 16 junior bull ride.

The next event on the calendar was the Lockie's Legacy Charity Rodeo at Crow's Nest, here Fraser Babbington won the first round of the bull ride with David Kennedy in second place. In the final David Kennedy was placed first, ahead of Reece Weller and Fraser Babbington with Kennedy and Babbington taking home the top two average places respectively. Meantime Michael Maher took out the saddle bronc, Dion Doro the under 16 junior bull ride, Harry Bridges the novice bull ride, Ty Payne the poddy ride and Cheyenne Whitwell the open and junior barrel race.

The Casino Beef Week rodeo on May 31 was rain affected but went ahead with a full all around program.

Winners on the day were Jayden Sims in the bull ride, Lachlan Ezzy in the saddle bronc, Steele Allston in the bareback, Luke Gall in the rope and tie, Dave Mawhinney in the steer wrestling, Cheyenne Whitwell in the open and junior barrel race, Katie Vaughan in the breakaway roping and Steve Augustin and Murray Whitwell in the team roping. Junior competitors had a great range of events to compete in on the day with Cody Kelly winning the junior bull ride, Beau Creighton winning the under 16 junior bull ride, Matthew Emes winning the junior steer ride, Ty Payne the poddy ride and Ashleigh Howard winning the junior breakaway roping.

The Caboolture Show Rodeo saw Cooyar's Jack McArthur win the open bull ride while it was Jack Capewell who won the saddle bronc and Matthew Makinson who took out the bareback bronc ride. Brock Eastwell won the rope and tie in 10.765 seconds while Marcus Jones was fastest in the steer wrestling with 4.740 seconds and his son Cooper won the poddy ride with a 69 point ride. Cheyenne Whitwell had a stellar day, taking out the open barrel race, junior barrel race and junior breakaway roping. In the open breakaway roping Judy Gough placed first with a 2.585 second run while local cowgirl Nicole Cavanagh won the steer undecorating and Matt Speedy and Jason McPhee won the team roping in 6.6 seconds.

Competitors who travelled north to Teebar were rewarded with a great new arena surface which was praised by many during the day. Here, Dave Mawhinney was the standout performer winning both the bull ride and saddle bronc. Ian Niemann won the bareback, Thomas Whitwell the rope and tie, George Wheeler the steer wrestling, Cheyenne Whitwell the open and junior barrel race, Simone Schultz the open breakaway roping while Lee Dickinson and Darren Milburn won the team roping.

That evening the Nambour Show Rodeo was held with Fraser Babbington winning the bull ride, Travis Ferrier the saddle bronc, Dinny Moran the bareback and Cheyenne Whitwell the barrel race.

Rosewood Show held a bull ride with Sam Champ taking home over \$900 for winning the bull ride.

Bonalbo Bull Ride on June 28 was also a good paying event with Matt Boland taking home over \$800 for the win there.

Laidley Bull and Bronc on April 4 once again saw Jack McArthur win the bull ride with Mark Collins taking out the bronc ride and Laura Bostock the barrel race.

The final event to be included in this month's results is the Canungra All round Rodeo. Matthew Young took out first place in the open bull ride while Mark Collins and Jack Capewell took out equal first place in the saddle bronc and Cohen Collins was number one in the bareback. The rope and tie saw Clay Gall do a 9.8 second run to win the event ahead of big brother Luke Gall. Steve Doneathy won the steer wrestling, while Jack Capewell backed up his performance in the saddle bronc to then go on and win the team roping with good friend Scott Augustin. The open barrel race was won by Cheyenne Whitwell while the open breakaway roping was won by Rachelle Carlo.

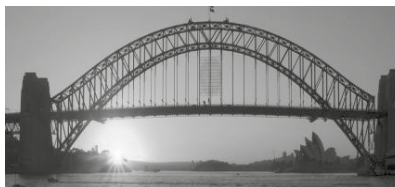
