

- Must include a minimum of all 7 Standard Events with a minimum prize money of \$500 per event
- Full points are awarded for individual titles and All Round titles

**POINTS AWARD RODEO**

- Must include a minimum of 3 Standard Events with minimum prize money of \$500 per event
- Half points are awarded for individual titles only

**BULL RIDE**

- Must include a minimum of a Bull Ride, Novice Bull Ride and Junior Bull with minimum prize money of \$1500, \$350 and \$200 respectively.
- Half points are awarded to individual event titles only

**JUNIOR RODEO**

- Must include the following events  
Under 8 – Barrel Race and Dummy Roping  
Under 12 – Barrel Race, Dummy Roping, Breakaway Roping, Pole Bending and Poddy Ride  
Under 16 – Barrel Race, Pole Bending, Calf Tying, Breakaway Roping and Boys Steer Ride  
Under 18 – Bull Ride, Saddle Ride, Bareback Ride, Chute Dogging, Team Roping, Rope & Tie, Barrel Race, Pole Bending and Breakaway Roping
- Age as of 1 January
- Points are awarded to Junior Rodeo Series only and are not awarded to individual event titles

**NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM**

Campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a Property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

**COMMITTEES**

### **IMPORTANT RULES**

All Juniors (including Day Members) must have suitable proof of age available on the day, should there be a need for verification.

**Junior Competitors who compete in any Junior and or Open Rodeo Events:**

- **TIME EVENT JUNIOR COMPETITORS:**  
**Must wear properly fitted AUSTRALIAN APPROVED HELMET with chin straps fastened at all times during the ride**

- **ROUGH STOCK JUNIOR COMPETITORS:**  
**Must wear properly fitted FULL FACE PROTECTIVE HELMET WITH CHIN STRAP FASTENED UP AT ALL TIMES during the ride**

Your helmet must be appropriately adjusted to fit you and chin straps fastened up before you ride. Chute Boss and or Officials may request to inspect the helmet.

- **Approved properly fitted protective VEST. If this request is not met, you will not be granted the ride and your stock will be turned out.**

- These rules include All Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.

- If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you Must STILL ABIDE BY THE Junior rules when competing in Junior events.

- Juniors competing in OPEN EVENTS MUST HAVE AN UPGRADED Open Membership as Junior membership only entitles you to compete in Junior events.

- If you wish to compete in an Open event you must UPGRADE your membership to Open Membership: Other Men's and Ladies' Open Membership of \$110.00 (from \$44.00 to \$154.00) and plus bond of \$60.00 (from \$15.00 to \$75.00).

- **NOTE:** If there is not a Junior event the same as the event you wish to compete in, you may compete in the Open event by paying Open day membership. However, with option you are not

- A Rookie is eligible for Novice Money until they "Break Open".

#### Rookie Breaks Open

1. Wins a title
  2. Accrues 1000 Novice points in an event
  3. Completes second year of membership
- (In all of the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only.)

#### ALL ROOKIE COMPETITORS MUST ADVISE THE OFFICE IN WRITING OF THEIR ROOKIE STATUS

#### Novice Competition:

- A Novice competitor is a member competing in an event not competed in by said member and has been a financial member of NRA for at least two years.
- A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points and Novice Money until they break open and become an open member. (Novice Points do not appear in the standings in the Newsletter. All enquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the NRA Office)

#### Breaking Open:

As a competitor "Breaks Open" they will be notified in writing from the Office and recorded in the "Break Open" Register. The Competitors who have "Broken Open" will be published in the monthly Newsletter. These competitors are no longer classed as a Novice Competitor and they are also no longer eligible for Novice money or points. However your Rookie (\*R\*) status will remain in the standings until the end of the Rodeo Season.





## BURNIN' DOWN THE HOUSE

A full report of the hottest rodeo action in South East Qld.

THE 2013 competition year wrapped up with a very competitive final few weeks of rodeo which saw the race for a number of titles come down to the wire.

A big day of bull riding on the final Saturday of October brought competition to an end for that month. Competitors contested the Capalaba Tavern event as well the Alstonville event.

Spectators at Capalaba witnessed a winning 84 point ride by Fraser Babbington in the open bull ride which was closely followed by John Foster who scored 83 points.

Meantime at Alstonville it was David Kennedy who was the star of the show, riding two head to take home the entire purse of over \$1500.

Competition for November kicked off with another bull ride event, this time for the Murwillumbah Show. Here Jeffrey Moretto scored 80 points to take the win in the open bull ride while Thomas Amos and John Foster split the novice bull ride on 70 points.

The final all around rodeo for 2013 was at Goombungee which once again saw just one score in the bull ride, this time from Harry Bridges with a 72. Other winners in rough stock events on the day included Brad Warburton in the saddle bronc and Dinny Moran in the bareback. At the time event end of the arena Thomas Whitwell had a great day, taking out a win in the rope and tie, steer wrestling and team roping. His sister Cheyenne also had a good day, winning the open barrel race while Skye Evans took out the junior barrel race. The open breakaway roping was won by Tammy Augustin while Denae Hart won the steer undecorating with a quick time of 1.549 seconds.

At the Parkwood Tavern bull ride Sam Dolbel was the only man to ride two head, placing equal second in the first round with Ben Seeds on 75 points, behind Reece Weller on 80 points. However Dolbel was the only qualified ride in the final to score 77 points and take home the average. He also won the novice bull ride on the night with a score of 75 points, this saw him walk away with close to \$3000 for the night.

The final competition event prior to finals was the Greenbank Wild side event which incorporated the final for that series. Matthew Young was the only score in the bull ride while Jack Capewell took out the saddle bronc and Matty Makinson the bareback. Bianca Weier won the open barrel race while Taylor Schultz took out the junior bull ride, Dylan Talbot the junior steer ride and Zane Hall the poddy ride.

It was then the start of the finals series for the 2013 competition year.

There were a number of standout performers at the finals with some of those walking away with titles. In the bull ride Jackson Worsfold showed good form to win both the Nambour and Caboolture round of the finals which was enough to earn him the finals average.

Fellow Kingaroy competitors Brad Cavanagh and David Liaver did the same in the team roping which also earned them the finals average header and heeler respectively and brought David the 2013 heeling title. Jesse Townsend won two rounds of the rope and tie and placed second in another to seal the rope and tie title for 2013. Junior barrel racer Skye Evans put up a good effort by winning the first two rounds of the finals and going on to take out the junior barrel racing title.






