NRA RODEO CATEGORIES

ALL ROUND CHAMPIONSHIP RODEO

- Must include a minimum of all 7 Standard Events with a minimum prize money of \$500 per event
- Full points are awarded for individual titles and All Round titles

POINTS AWARD RODEO

- Must include a minimum of 3 Standard Events with minimum prize money of \$500 per event
- Half points are awarded for individual titles only

BULL RIDE

- Must include a minimum of a Bull Ride, Novice Bull Ride and Junior Bull with minimum prize money of \$1500, \$350 and \$200 respectively.
- Half points are awarded to individual event titles only

JUNIOR RODEO

- Must include the following events
Under 8 – Barrel Race and Dummy Roping
Under 12 – Barrel Race, Dummy Roping, Breakaway Roping, Pole Bending and Paddy Ride
Under 16 – Barrel Race, Pole Bending, Calf Tying, Breakaway Roping and Boys Steer Ride
Under 18 – Bull Ride, Saddle Ride, Bareback Ride, Chute Dogging, Team Roping, Rope & Tie, Barrel Race, Pole Bending and Breakaway Roping
- Age as of 1 January
- Points are awarded to Junior Rodeo Series only and are not awarded to individual event titles

NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

Campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a Property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

COMMITTEES

Please do not hesitate to contact the NRA Office if you require any assistance with the organisation of your rodeo.

The NRA Office are readily available to help you with obtaining your arena officials, planning of your events and program, and any other queries you may have to make your rodeo run as smoothly as possible with less work for your committee.

If you have any issues relating to Public Liability Insurance or your rodeo promotion, please don't hesitate to contact the NRA office as we will only be too happy to assist you.

IMPORTANT RULES

All Juniors (including Day Members) must have suitable proof of age available on the day, should there be a need for verification.

Junior Competitors who compete in any Junior and or Open Rodeo Events:

- **TIME EVENT JUNIOR COMPETITORS:**
Must wear properly fitted AUSTRALIAN APPROVED HELMET with chin straps fastened at all times during the ride
- **ROUGH STOCK JUNIOR COMPETITORS:**
Must wear properly fitted FULL FACE PROTECTIVE HELMET WITH CHIN STRAP FASTENED UP AT ALL TIMES during the ride
 Your helmet must be appropriately adjusted to fit you and chin straps fastened up before you ride. Chute Boss and or Officials may request to inspect the helmet.
- Approved properly fitted protective VEST. If this request is not met, you will not be granted the ride and your stock will be turned out.
- These rules include All Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.
- If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you Must STILL ABIDE BY THE Junior rules when competing in Junior events.
- Juniors competing in OPEN EVENTS MUST HAVE AN UPGRADED Open Membership as Junior membership only entitles you to compete in Junior events.
- If you wish to compete in an Open event you must UPGRADE your membership to Open Membership: Other Men's and Ladies' Open Membership of \$110.00 (from \$44.00 to \$154.00) and plus bond of \$60.00 (from \$15.00 to \$75.00).
- **NOTE:** If there is not a Junior event the same as the event you wish to compete in, you may compete in the Open event by paying Open day membership. However, with option you are not entitled to receive points, only prize money.

ROOKIE AND NOVICE

Rookie Competition:

- A Rookie is a member in their first or second year of Rodeo.
- A Rookie Title can be won in their first or second year of membership.
- Points are accrued from Open Competition Only. (Rookie points are recorded in the Open Standings in the newsletter with an *R* beside the competitor's name).
- A Rookie is eligible for Novice Money until they "Break Open".

Rookie Breaks Open

1. Wins a title
 2. Accrues 1000 Novice points in an event
 3. Completes second year of membership
- (In all of the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only.)

ALL ROOKIE COMPETITORS MUST ADVISE THE OFFICE IN WRITING OF THEIR ROOKIE STATUS

Novice Competition:

- A Novice competitor is a member competing in an event not competed in by said member and has been a financial member of NRA for at least two years.
- A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points and Novice Money until they break open and become an open member. (Novice Points do not appear in the standings in the Newsletter. All enquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the NRA Office)

Breaking Open:

As a competitor "Breaks Open" they will be notified in writing from the Office and recorded in the "Break Open" Register. The Competitors who have "Broken Open" will be published in the monthly Newsletter. These competitors are no longer classed as a Novice Competitor and they are also no longer eligible for Novice money or points. However your Rookie (*R*) status will remain in the standings until the end of the Rodeo Season.

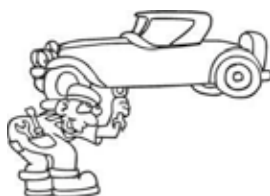

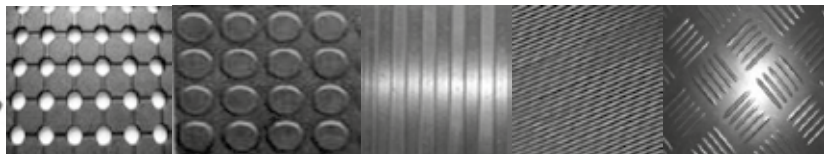

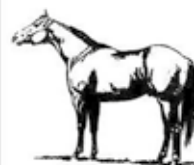

BURNIN' DOWN THE HOUSE

A full report of the hottest rodeo action in South East Qld.

To kick off the 2014 rodeo season the Carlton Mid Series rolled into the Blue Mountain Hotel, Toowoomba. Andrew Kelly was the only scorer in round one of the bull ride and took home over \$2100 for that round alone, while Frazer Babbington came back in the short-go round with a big scoring 88 point ride to win the short-go round and the average.

Next on the calendar was the Norths Rugby Leagues Club Rodeo in Ipswich with the winners on the day being Ryan Dickens in the open bull ride, John McNamee in the saddle bronc, Ashley Clem in the bareback, Zane Hall in the junior steer ride and Bianca Weier in the barrel race.

A number of National Rodeo Association members travelled to Lawrence for the dual affiliated rodeo which saw ABCRA competitors take home the majority of the placings however Reece Weller placed second in the bull ride and Jackson Felton third, Marcus Jones fourth in the steer wrestling, Lee Shegog and Jason Fredericks third in the team roping and Katie Vaughan second in the steer undecorating.

National Rodeo Association competitors kicked off 2014 with the annual Goomeri New Year's Eve event which saw big nominations for the full program rodeo. From 27 open bull riders it was Matthew Gakowski who took home top honours with a 79 point ride earning him over \$700 for his efforts. The saddle bronc also had strong nominations with 20 competitors stepping up to take the challenge upon the Hank McArthur string of bucking horses. In the end it was a tie for first place between Kane Clayton-Green and Jim Ryan with Joel Hill and Dave Mawhinney wrapping up the placings. The bareback was won by Billy Blacker followed by the only other scores on the board from Parrish May and Ryan Zadow. The rope and tie placings featured the young-guns in the event with Mitch Eastwell taking the win with a 10 second flat run followed by Jay Green, Joshua Green and Clay Hall. Shane Hart took out the steerwrestling with western Queensland competitor Dusty Tattam close on his heels followed by Steve Doneathy and Marcus Jones. The open barrel race was a close event with Kate Benedict winning by just 0.002 of a second from Christine Bushell while Laura Bostock and Kim Clarke wrapped up the placings. In the open breakaway roping Chrystal Lennox-Pool got out and roped her calf in a quick time of 2.450 seconds to be ahead of placegetters Katie Vaughan, Cameille O'Tool and Jodie Aylward. The team roping featured 41 teams but it was Bob Armitage and Steve Sutherland who were the quickest with a run of 7.270 seconds. The novice bull ride was won by Matt Sly, the junior barrel race by Ashleigh Howard and the poddy ride by Brandon Long.

The following day a number of junior competitors and their supporters stayed on for the junior rodeo which featured a full program of events and gave all competitors a good opportunity to try new events as well as take part in their usual ones.

Next on the calendar was the Cudgen Leagues Club points award event. At Cudgen the bull ride was won by Matt Boland, the saddle ride by Mark Collins, the novice bull ride by Jackson Felton, the junior bull ride by Bailey Schultz and the junior steer ride by Ethan McConnell.

On January 9 Byron Bay crowds flocked to the football club for the annual rodeo which also saw good nominations. Here Jackson Felton won the open bull ride while Mark Collins once again took out the saddle ride. The novice bull ride at the event was won by Brenton Kuhrt while Jackson Felton took out second place. Junior competitors contested the under 16 junior bull ride and poddy ride with Clay Hall and Blake Weier taking top honors respectively. The open barrel race was a close event with Kristy Nagel being the eventual winner ahead of Cheyenne Whitwell, Skye Evans and Bianca Weier.

At Noosa Pirates Rugby League Club on January 11 the bulls proved too tough with no scores in the bull ride. The saddle bronc riders had more luck with Joel Hill winning the event followed by Brad Warburton, Kane Clayton-Green and Kingsley Moore who tied for third and fourth. In the bareback Dinny Moran scored a big 81 points to take home first place ahead of Steele Allston, Ryan Zadow and Nathan Garlick. The novice bull ride and poddy ride saw only one scorer in each with Keelan Alexander and Cooper Jones taking home all the prize money for their events respectively.

At the Kawana Waters Tavern Carlton Mid Series bull ride on January 18 it was an 81 point ride by Jeffrey Moretto which won the first round while Trent McGuire came up with the same score to win the final. At the end of the night it was a tie between Ryan Dickens and Trent McGuire to take home the average with 153 points. Other events on the program saw Kenny Hilan win the novice bull ride, Beau Creighton win the under 16 junior bull ride and Zane Hall win the poddy ride.

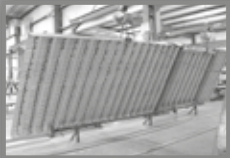

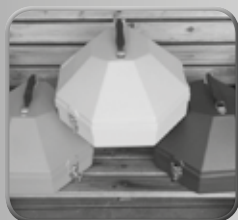

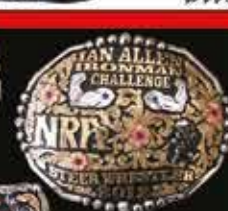
