## NRA RODEO CATEGORIES

### ALL ROUND CHAMPIONSHIP RODEO

- Must include a minimum of all 7 Standard Events with a minimum prize money of \$500 per event
- Full points are awarded for individual titles and All Round titles

### POINTS AWARD RODEO

- Must include a minimum of 3 Standard Events with minimum prize money of \$500 per event
- Half points are awarded for individual titles only

### BULL RIDE

- Must include a minimum of a Bull Ride, Novice Bull Ride and Junior Bull with minimum prize money of \$1500, \$350 and \$200 respectively.
- Half points are awarded to individual event titles only

### JUNIOR RODEO

- Must include the following events  
Under 8 – Barrel Race and Dummy Roping  
Under 12 – Barrel Race, Dummy Roping, Breakaway Roping, Pole Bending and Poddy Ride  
Under 16 – Barrel Race, Pole Bending, Calf Tying, Breakaway Roping and Boys Steer Ride  
Under 18 – Bull Ride, Saddle Ride, Bareback Ride, Chute Dogging, Team Roping, Rope & Tie, Barrel Race, Pole Bending and Breakaway Roping
- Age as of 1 January
- Points are awarded to Junior Rodeo Series only and are not awarded to individual event titles

## NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

Campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a Property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

## COMMITTEES

Please do not hesitate to contact the NRA Office if you require any assistance with the organisation of your rodeo.

The NRA Office are readily available to help you with obtaining your arena officials, planning of your events and program, and any other queries you may have to make your rodeo run as smoothly as possible with less work for your committee.

If you have any issues relating to Public Liability Insurance or your rodeo promotion, please don't hesitate to contact the NRA office as we will only be too happy to assist you.

## IMPORTANT RULES

All juniors (including Day Members) must have suitable proof of age available on the day, should there be a need for verification.

### Junior Competitors who compete in any Junior and or Open Rodeo Events:

- **TIME EVENT JUNIOR COMPETITORS:**  
Must wear properly fitted FULL FACE PROTECTIVE HELMET WITH CHIN STRAP FASTENED UP AT ALL TIMES during the ride
- **ROUGH STOCK JUNIOR COMPETITORS:**  
Must wear properly fitted FULL FACE PROTECTIVE HELMET WITH CHIN STRAP FASTENED UP AT ALL TIMES during the ride  
 Your helmet must be appropriately adjusted to fit you and chin straps fastened up before you ride. Chute Boss and or Officials may request to inspect the helmet.
- Approved properly fitted protective VEST. If this request is not met, you will not be granted the ride and your stock will be turned out.
- These rules include All Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.
- If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you Must STILL ABIDE BY THE Junior rules when competing in junior events.
- Juniors competing in OPEN EVENTS MUST HAVE AN UPGRADED Open Membership as junior membership only entitles you to compete in junior events.
- If you wish to compete in an Open event you must UPGRADE your membership to Open Membership: Other Men's and Ladies' Open Membership of \$110.00 (from \$44.00 to \$154.00) and plus bond of \$60.00 (from \$15.00 to \$75.00).
- **NOTE:** If there is not a junior event the same as the event you wish to compete in, you may compete in the Open event by paying Open day membership. However, with option you are not entitled to receive points, only prize money.

## Reports

### Apologies

I have two apologies to make. The first concerns the lateness of the nominations for Directors in the newsletter. According to our memorandums and articles, the nominations need to be in by the 20<sup>th</sup> September, but with our bi-monthly newsletter, the advertisement for this came out late and therefore made any nominations null and void.

The only option left to us was for the board to appoint directors for a 12 month stint. We didn't want the members to feel like we had taken the decision making process out of their hands, so after legal advice we decided to call for expressions of interest for the available positions. That gave the members present at the AGM the opportunity to vote for those Directors.

There were only two events where we had multiple expressions of interest, which was the bull ride and the breakaway roping, and they were voted for. I do sincerely apologise on behalf of the Board for not providing adequate time for our voting process to occur and assure you that we have measures in place to ensure this doesn't happen again.

The second apology was for a misunderstanding I conveyed to the members at the meeting that was held at Toogoolawah Rodeo. I had misunderstood the proposition by Hall Rodeo Co. regarding Gatton Finals Rodeo concerning who was to pay for the prize money. In an email received by the Board from the Halls, they had clearly stated that we (the association) would put up the prize money and in return get the bar and food.

- (In all of the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only.)

## **ALL ROOKIE COMPETITORS MUST ADVISE** **THE OFFICE IN WRITING OF THEIR ROOKIE** **STATUS**

### **Novice Competition:**

- A Novice competitor is a member competing in an event not competed in by said member and has been a financial member of NRA for at least two years.
- A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points and Novice Money until they break open and become an open member. (Novice Points do not appear in the standings in the Newsletter. All enquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the NRA Office)

### **Breaking Open:**

As a competitor "Breaks Open" they will be notified in writing from the Office and recorded in the "Break Open" Register. The Competitors who have "Broken Open" will be published in the monthly Newsletter. These competitors are no longer classed as a Novice Competitor and they are also no longer eligible for Novice money or points. However your Rookie (\*R\*) status will remain in the standings until the end of the Rodeo Season.

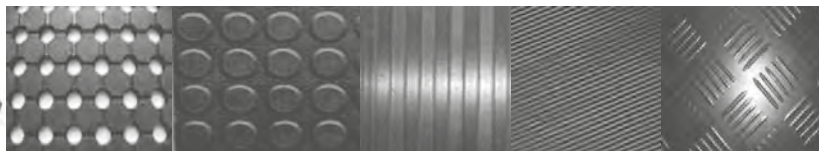

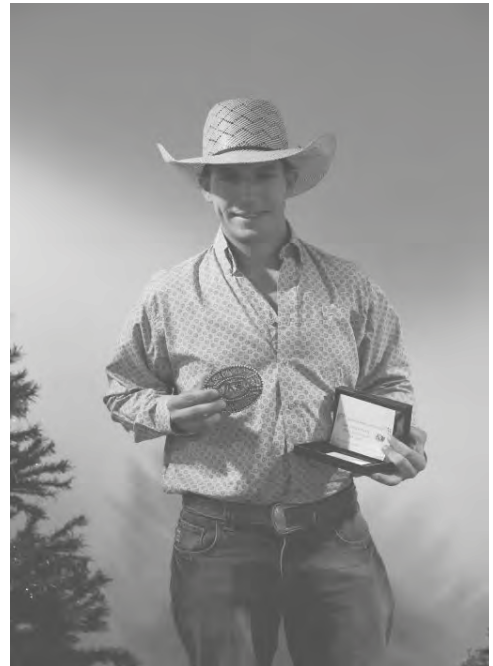
