## NRA RODEO CATEGORIES

### ALL ROUND CHAMPIONSHIP RODEO

- Must include a minimum of all 7 Standard Events with a minimum prize money of \$500 per event
- Full points are awarded for individual titles and All Round titles

### POINTS AWARD RODEO

- Must include a minimum of 3 Standard Events with minimum prize money of \$500 per event
- Half points are awarded for individual titles only

### BULL RIDE

- Must include a minimum of a Bull Ride, Novice Bull Ride and Junior Bull with minimum prize money of \$1500, \$350 and \$200 respectively.
- Half points are awarded to individual event titles only

### JUNIOR RODEO

- Must include the following events  
Under 8 – Barrel Race and Dummy Roping  
Under 12 – Barrel Race, Dummy Roping, Breakaway Roping, Pole Bending and Poddy Ride  
Under 16 – Barrel Race, Pole Bending, Calf Tying, Breakaway Roping and Boys Steer Ride  
Under 18 – Bull Ride, Saddle Ride, Bareback Ride, Chute Dogging, Team Roping, Rope & Tie, Barrel Race, Pole Bending and Breakaway Roping
- Age as of 1 January
- Points are awarded to Junior Rodeo Series only and are not awarded to individual event titles

## NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

Campdraft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a Property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

## COMMITTEES

Please do not hesitate to contact the NRA Office if you require any assistance with the organisation of your rodeo.

The NRA Office are readily available to help you with obtaining your arena officials, planning of your events and program, and any other queries you may have to make your rodeo run as smoothly as possible with less work for your committee.

If you have any issues relating to Public Liability Insurance or your rodeo promotion, please don't hesitate to contact the NRA office as we will only be too happy to assist you.

## IMPORTANT RULES

All juniors (including Day Members) must have suitable proof of age available on the day, should there be a need for verification.

### Junior Competitors who compete in any Junior and or Open Rodeo Events:

- **TIME EVENT JUNIOR COMPETITORS:**  
***Must wear properly fitted HORSE RIDING PROTECTIVE HELMET WITH CHIN STRAP FASTENED UP AT ALL TIMES during the ride***
- **ROUGH STOCK JUNIOR COMPETITORS:**  
***Must wear properly fitted FULL FACE PROTECTIVE HELMET WITH CHIN STRAP FASTENED UP AT ALL TIMES during the ride***  
Your helmet must be appropriately adjusted to fit you and chin straps fastened up before you ride. Chute Boss and or Officials may request to inspect the helmet.
- ***Approved properly fitted protective VEST. If this request is not met, you will not be granted the ride and your stock will be turned out.***
- These rules include All Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.
- If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you Must STILL ABIDE BY THE Junior rules when competing in junior events.
- Juniors competing in OPEN EVENTS MUST HAVE AN UPGRADED Open Membership as junior membership only entitles you to compete in junior events.
- If you wish to compete in an Open event you must UPGRADE your membership to Open Membership: Other Men's and Ladies' Open Membership of \$110.00 (from \$44.00 to \$154.00) and plus bond of \$60.00 (from \$15.00 to \$75.00).
- **NOTE:** If there is not a junior event the same as the event you wish to compete in, you may compete in the Open event by paying Open day membership. However, with option you are not entitled to receive points, only prize money.

### **NOTICE FOR JUNIOR MEMBERS & PARENTS**

Following a number of reported incidents, a motion was carried at the last Full Board Meeting that any under-age junior member found guilty of consuming alcohol in the licenced bar area at an NRA affiliated rodeo will face a minimum 10 rodeo suspension. The objects of our association include “promoting the sport to a national recognised standard” and “assisting committees in promoting professional rodeos”. This reported behaviour is detrimental to achieving those objectives and will not be tolerated.

ALL COMPETITORS COMPETING IN JUNIOR EVENTS MUST WEAR A HELMET.

EVEN AFTER 18 YEARS OF AGE AND STILL COMPETING IN JUNIOR EVENTS TILL THE END OF THE YEAR YOU ARE STILL REQUIRED TO WEAR A HELMET.

### **ROOKIE AND NOVICE**

**Rookie Competition:**

- A Rookie is a member in their first or second year of Rodeo.
- A Rookie Title can be won in their first or second year of membership.
- Points are accrued from Open Competition Only. (Rookie points are recorded in the Open Standings in the newsletter with an \*R\* beside the competitor's name).
- A Rookie is eligible for Novice Money until they “Break Open”.

**Rookie Breaks Open**

1. Wins a title
2. Accrues 1000 Novice points in an event
3. Completes second year of membership  
(In all of the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only.)

### **ALL ROOKIE COMPETITORS MUST ADVISE THE OFFICE IN WRITING OF THEIR ROOKIE STATUS**

**Novice Competition:**

- A Novice competitor is a member competing in an event not competed in by said member and has been a financial member of NRA for at least two years.
- A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points and Novice Money until they break open and become an open member. (Novice Points do not appear in the standings in the Newsletter. All enquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the NRA Office)

**Breaking Open:**

As a competitor “Breaks Open” they will be notified in writing from the Office and recorded in the “Break Open” Register. The Competitors who have “Broken Open” will be published in the monthly Newsletter. These competitors are no longer classed as a Novice Competitor and they are also no longer eligible for Novice money or points. However your Rookie (\*R\*) status will remain in the standings until the end of the Rodeo Season.

## SPECIAL GENERAL MEETING MOTIONS:-

1. No bull and bronc/bull ride should be allowed to be run on the same day as all round rodeo. All Round Rodeos should have preference over any other event ran on that day.

2. Members are allowed 3 preference a year to help members get to 2 rodeos on the same day or to attend family commitments, Anyone that preferences for wrong reasons e.g. watch cattle run first should be fined \$50.00

In the case of 2 runs per person points would be 1st - 90 points per person, 2nd - 70 points per person, 3rd - 50 points per person, 4th - 30 points per person.

 • A competitor has until they reach 1000 recorded open event to nominate for an event Rookie Title.  
 • A competitor may nominate more than once for an event, however they must complete a nomination form each year.  
 • If a competitor commences the points year as a Rookie, they retain that status regardless of money won at the previous point’s year National Finals.  
 • The year in which a competitor reaches 1000 points is the competitors’ final rookie year for that event.  
 • All Rookie competitors must advise Head Office in writing by completing a Rookie Nomination Form. This is to be done by 30 June each year.  
 • A competitor may only win one Rookie title per event.

 • Novice points awarded is accumulated for the lifetime of the member.  
 • Junior competitors may continue to compete in Novice events until they either turn 18 years of age or win an Open event.

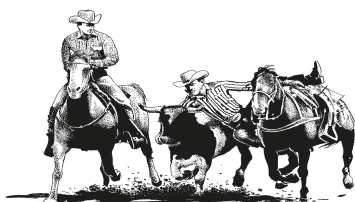
