

NRA RODEO CATEGORIES

ALL ROUND CHAMPIONSHIP RODEO

- Must include a minimum of all 8 Standard Events with a minimum prize money of \$500 per event
- Full points are awarded for individual titles and All Round titles

POINTS AWARD RODEO

- Must include a minimum of 3 Standard Events with minimum prize money of \$500 per event
- Half points are awarded for individual titles only

BULL RIDE

- Must include a minimum of a Bull Ride, Novice Bull Ride and Junior Bull with minimum prize money of \$1500, \$350 and \$200 respectively.
- Half points are awarded to individual event titles only

JUNIOR RODEO

Must include the following events

<u>Under 8</u> – Barrel Race and Dummy Roping

<u>Under 12</u> – Barrel Race, Dummy Roping, Breakaway Roping, Pole Bending and Poddy Ride

<u>Under 16</u> – Barrel Race, Pole Bending, Calf Tying, Breakaway Roping and Boys Steer Ride

<u>Under 18</u> – Bull Ride, Saddle Ride, Bareback Ride, Chute Dogging, Team Roping, Rope & Tie, Barrel Race, Pole Bending and Breakaway Roping

- Age as of 1 January
- Points are awarded to Junior Rodeo Series only and are not awarded to individual event titles

NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

Camp draft, rodeo and show committees must ensure their ground or arena is registered with DPI&F and has a Property Identification Code (PIC). Where a ground or arena does not have a PIC, contact your local stock inspector to obtain the necessary registration forms and a PIC.

COMMITTEES

Please do not hesitate to contact the NRA Office if you require any assistance with the organisation of your rodeo.

The NRA Office are readily available to help you with obtaining your arena officials, planning of your events and program, and any other queries you may have to make your rodeo run as smoothly as possible with less work for your committee.

If you have any issues relating to Public Liability Insurance or your rodeo promotion, please don't hesitate to contact the NRA office as we will only be too happy to assist you.

RULE NOTICE REMINDER

Page 32. Standard disqualifications for all Rough Stock Events.

12. In the case of a competitor coming in contact with the arena with their free hand or arm, and in the judge's opinion, such contact has aided the competitor, automatic disqualification shall occur.

IMPORTANT RULES

All juniors (including Day Members) must have suitable proof of age available on the day, should there be a need for verification.

Junior Competitors who compete in any Junior and or Open Rodeo Events:

- TIME EVENT JUNIOR COMPETITORS:
 Must wear properly fitted HORSE RIDING PROTECTIVE HELMET
 WITH CHIN STRAP FASTENED UP AT ALL TIMES during the ride
- ROUGH STOCK JUNIOR COMPETITORS:
 <u>Must wear properly fitted FULL FACE PROTECTIVE HELMET WITH</u>
 <u>CHIN STRAP FASTENED UP AT ALL TIMES during the ride</u>
 Your helmet must be appropriately adjusted to fit you and chin straps fastened up before you ride. Chute Boss and or Officials may request to
- Approved properly fitted protective VEST. If this request is not met, you will not be granted the ride and your stock will be turned out.

inspect the helmet.

- These rules include All Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.
- If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you Must STILL ABIDE BY THE Junior rules when competing in junior events.
- Juniors competing in OPEN EVENTS MUST HAVE AN UPGRADED Open Membership as junior membership only entitles you to compete in junior events.
- If you wish to compete in an Open event, you must UPGRADE your membership to Open Membership: Other Men's and Ladies' Open Membership of \$110.00 (from \$44.00 to \$154.00) and plus bond of \$60.00 (from \$15.00 to \$75.00).
- NOTE: If there is not a junior event the same as the event you wish to compete in, you may compete in the Open event by paying Open day membership. However, with option you are not entitled to receive points, only prize money.

ROOKIE AND NOVICE

Rookie Competition

For all events, a competitor may compete in either Novice or Open competition until total recorded points in that event have reached 1000 however only points won in the open competition will count towards a Rookie Title, or breaking Rookie status and HAVE not won a title in that event with any other Association.

- 1. A Rookie is a competitor from their first two (2) years of open competition.
- 2. A competitor has until they reach 1000 recorded points in an open event to nominate for an event Rookie Title. The year in which a competitor reaches 1000 points is the competitor's final rookie year for that event.
- All Rookie competitors must advice Head Office in writing by completing a Rookie Nomination Form. This is to be done by 30th June each year.
- 4. A competitor may only win one Rookie title per event.

Rookie Breaks Open

- 1. Wins a title.
- 2. Accrues 1000 Novice points in an event.
- 3. Completes second year of membership
- 4. (In all of the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only).

Novice Competition

A Novice competitor is also eligible to compete in open competition until such time as novice and open points reach 1000. All novice and junior rough stock competitors must wear protective equipment such as a helmet and vest. (Novice Points do not appear in the standings on the website or in Newsletter. All enquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the NRA office).

Only monies won at NRA affiliated points awarded rodeos count towards breaking novice status.

Novice points awarded is accumulated for the lifetime of the member. Junior competitors may continue to compete in Novice events until either turn 18 years of age or win an open event.

NRA Drug and Alcohol Policy

Aim:

The National Rodeo Association (NRA) has a zero tolerance towards drugs and alcohol and is committed to doing everything within its power to ensure that all employees, contract personnel and riders of NRA are not exposed to the risks inherently involved with the use of illegal substances or the excessive consumption of alcohol in or around the sport of Rodeo.

Principles:

- a. It is the responsibility of the individual to present themselves fit to compete or work.
- b. As a NRA Member / Day Member / Employee you are sometimes placed in a high risk environment and as such no NRA Member / Day Member / Employee may compete and or work at a NRA Event if under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- c. At no time are a NRA Member / Day Member / Employee allowed to have illegal drugs in their possession while at a NRA Event or associated event function (including but not limited to After Parties, Pre Event Meet and Greet, and Autograph Signings etc.).
- d. At no time is a NRA Member / Day Member / Employee allowed to have any other type of drug in their possession or on NRA Event premises unless it is for medication purposes, in this situation the person must present themselves with the appropriate medical advice to the designated NRA Event Official and follow all procedures for their place in the event whether it be rider, protection athlete, stock contractor and or event official.
- e. No NRA Member / Day Member / Employee will be allowed to compete or participate in a NRA Event whilst they are affected or under the influence of a performance altering drug or alcohol.
- f. To fulfil legal and contractual obligations all NRA Members / Day Members / Employees will adhere to this policy. This policy will have the final outcome over what disciplinary action will be taken in accordance with this policy.
- g. Testing will be conducted at two differing instances;

<u>Random Testing</u> – At any NRA Sanctioned Event you may be asked to participate in a random drug and alcohol test, refusal to participate will be classed as a non-negative result.

<u>Suspicion of use</u> – A NRA Official (Board Director/Judges/Arena Director) has the right to challenge any NRA Member / Day Member that they feel is acting as if under the influence of drugs or alcohol to a drug and alcohol test. Symptoms may include: Slurring speech, drowsiness, heavy eyes, uncontrolled bodily movement, irrational behaviour, moodiness, violent behaviour, paranoia. etc.

The Board of NRA wish all Members / Day Members / Employees to understand that the safety and wellbeing of their Members / Day Members / Employees is their highest priority, and hope that the implementation of this policy will convey the direction and importance that this issue has for our company. The Association will offer assistance and or arrange counselling and/or rehabilitation for alcohol and drug abuse. NRA will endeavour to carry out random drug and alcohol screening on its Members / Day Members / Employees regularly. This will be carried out by a suitably accredited tester or nominated medical advisor who will be available at the scheduled time of testing. Details of all test results will not be disclosed to anyone that does not have a need to know.

<u>Process for Random testing - Negative result</u>

- 1. The Member / Day Member / Employee will be told of the drug test immediately before being required to give the sample.
- 2. The Member / Day Member / Employee will accompany the relevant safety or management personnel to the testing facility of the company's choosing.
- 3. The test will be conducted and results given.
- 4. Upon return of a negative result you will be free to continue on with normal duties.
- 5. The evidence of the test will be logged on.

<u>Process for Random testing - Non negative result</u>


- 1. The Member / Day Member / Employee will be told of the drug test immediately before being required to give the sample. (If the Member / Day Member / Employee refuses to give a sample the test will automatically be deemed as non-negative).
- 2. The Member / Day Member / Employee will accompany the relevant safety or management personnel to the testing facility of the company's choosing.
- 3. The test will be conducted and results given.
- 4. Upon return of a non-negative result (BAL over 0.05% or the presence of a drug where the reading is at or exceeds AS4308:2001) you will not be allowed to compete and or partake in your duties at the event, you will be interviewed by the manager in charge (you may ask to have a support person present), and given the option to retest, if the test remains non negative then the retest is at the Member / Day Member / Employee cost however if the test is then negative NRA will pay the cost. Each case will be dealt with on its own circumstances but typically.

Alcohol

- # First offence involving alcohol will result in being immediately stood down from the event without pay or refund of entry fee and a written 6 event suspension (All NRA events) will be given.
- # Second offence involving alcohol will result in immediate termination of your membership and or employment (All NRA events).

Illegal Drugs

- # First offence involving drugs will result in being immediately stood down without pay or refund of your entry fee and a written 6 event suspension at all NRA events will be given. The Member / Day Member / Employee will be provided to show the association evidence of a negative drug test that is carried out by a nominated medical advisor at the member/employee's expense. Once NRA has proof of a negative test it will then be up to the Executive Board to decide on what provisions the Member / Day Member / Employee will return.
- # Second offence involving drugs will result in immediate termination of your membership and or employment (All NRA Events).
- 5. The evidence of the test will be logged on the NRA server and kept permanently.
