- Must include a minimum of a Bull Ride, Novice Bull Ride and Junior Bull with minimum prize money of \$1500, \$350 and \$200 respectively.
- Half points are awarded to individual event titles only

- Must include the following events

IMPORTANT RULES

Juniors:

1. These rules include All Juniors holding an UPGRADED Open membership competing in BOTH Junior and Open events during the current Rodeo season.
2. If you turn 18 YEARS OF AGE during the current Rodeo season you Must STILL ABIDE BY THE Junior rules when competing in junior events.
3. Junior Members competing in open events must have an upgraded Open Membership to be eligible for points or as a junior member be able to step up into the open events and will not be entitled to receive points in those events. Junior Day Members will require to pay open Day Membership to compete in Open Events.
4. All juniors (including Day Members) must have suitable proof of age available on the day, should there be a need for verification.
5. All Junior Competitors must wear an approved skullcap as per Australian Standards in Open and Junior Events. All helmets must be properly fitted with chin strap fastened always once mounted. Chute Boss and or Officials may request to inspect helmets.

Dress Code:

- a) All rodeo personnel competing and officiating at a rodeo must be in full western dress one (1) hour prior to the rodeo commencing or when they enter the rodeo grounds to conclusion. Western attire consists of a hat, boots, jeans of western pants and a long sleeve western shirt with sleeves buttoned down and a collar. All attire must be worn in a neat and tidy manner. The rule applies to competitors, chute boss, announcers, pick-up teams, judges, timekeepers, central entries personnel, stock contractors and their assistants. Clowns may wear runners. Sleeves may be rolled up on riding hand in Rough Stock Events.
- b) Should an appointed Director or Official deem a competitor to be wearing unsuitable attire, the competitor may be called from the arena:
 - i. Instructed to change attire
 - ii. Fined
 - iii. Disqualified for non-compliance in either (i) or (ii).

Drug and Alcohol Policy:

The NRA has a zero tolerance towards drugs and alcohol and is committed to doing everything within its power to ensure that all employees, contract personnel and riders of NRA are not exposed to the risks inherently involved with the use of illegal substances or the excessive consumption of alcohol in or around the sport of Rodeo. You may be asked to participate in a random drug and alcohol test at any NRA sanctioned event. Refusal to participate will be classified as a non-negative result. The complete Drug and Alcohol Policy can be located on the NRA web site.

Day Members:

As per NRA Rule Book: *Nomination procedures as per Members (Page 20)*. Apart from been eligible to nominate on the day of the rodeo for a maximum of 3 rodeos for events that are chute drawn or before stock draws have commenced in open events subject to the discretion of the Committee and Contractor. An additional fee is payable for Men's, Ladies and Junior for Day Membership. Must have their entry money plus day membership fee to the NRA Office by the designated date. Failure to do so will result in entries not being accepted. Day Members are required to sign a day membership form binding them to abide by the Constitution and Rules of this Association and code of practice on the sport of rodeo. A parent/legal guardian's signature is required on the form for under 18 years of age Competitors. All Day Members are required to complete this form prior to competing. Failure to do this will result in disqualification.

Entry Times/Preferences:

Financial members will have 3 preferences per year with a further option of placing trades. The Rodeo program and position draws for all events will be posted on the NRA website by Wednesday night prior to the rodeo and it will be the responsibility of the competitor to trade out with another competitor if they wish to change sections. Barrel Race Trades: (Open & Juniors) can only trade with the competitor of the same position draw in different sections, if trade is done with a competitor in a different position draw than both competitors will be placed in last position draw of each section. It is then the responsibility of the competitor to advise the NRA Office prior to 12 noon on Friday of any changes.

Men's Bull Ride:

Only recognised Bull Ropes to be used. Ropes must have a bell or bells attached by a loose rope or strap.

U15 Junior Steer Ride:

Only recognised Bull Ropes to be used. Ropes must have a bell or bells attached by a loose rope or strap.

7-U12 Poddy Ride:

Only recognised Bull Ropes to be used. Ropes must have a bell or bells attached by a loose rope or strap.

JUNIOR COMPETITORS

All Junior Members competing must wear a helmet fastened tightly in all events.

Even after 18 years of age and competing in junior events till the end of the year you are still required to wear a helmet.



NOTICE FOR JUNIOR MEMBERS & PARENTS

Following several reported incidents, a motion was carried at the full Board Meeting that any under-age junior member found guilty of consuming alcohol in the licenced bar area at an NRA affiliated rodeo will face a minimum 10 rodeo suspension. The objects of our association include "promoting the sport to a national recognised standard" and "assisting committees in promoting professional rodeos". This reported behaviour is detrimental to achieving those objectives and will not be tolerated.

ROOKIE AND NOVICE COMPETITORS

Rookie Competition

For all events, a competitor may compete in either Novice or Open competition until total recorded points in that event have reached 1000 however only points won in the open competition will count towards a Rookie Title, or breaking Rookie status and have not won a title in that event with any other Association.

1. A Rookie is a competitor from their first two (2) years of open competition.
2. A competitor has until they reach 1000 recorded points in an open event to nominate for an event Rookie Title. The year in which a competitor reaches 1000 points is the competitor's final rookie year for that event.
3. All Rookie competitors must advise Head Office in writing by completing a Rookie Nomination Form. This is to be done by 30th June each year.
4. A competitor may only win one Rookie title per event.

Rookie Break Open

1. Wins a title.
2. Accrues 1000 Novice points in an event
3. Completes second year of membership

(In all the above the member will then be deemed to be an open competitor only).

Novice Competition

- a) A Novice competitor is eligible to compete in open and novice competition until such time as novice and open points reach a 1000, the novice competitor will have then broken open and therefore be able to compete in open competition only
- b) All junior rough stock competitors must wear protective equipment such as a helmet and vest, when competing in open, novice and junior events.
- c) All novice competitors must wear protective equipment such as a helmet and vest, when competing in open and novice Bull Ride

(Novice Points do not appear in standings on the website or in Newsletter. All enquiries regarding Novice Points should be directed to the NRA Office).

Only monies won at NRA affiliated points awarded rodeos count towards breaking novice status.

Novice points awarded is accumulated for the lifetime of the member.

RULE UPDATE:

Commencing for the 2020 Rodeo Season the 7-U12 Mini Bull Ride and U15 Mini Bull Ride will be points awarded events. The points will be included with the 7-U12 Poddy Ride and U15 Junior Steer Ride, as such 7-U12 Mini Bull Ride points included with the 7-U12 Poddy Ride and the U15 Mini Bull Ride points included with the U15 Junior Steer Ride.

PREFERENCE / TRADING RULE:

Central Entries –

4. Financial members will have 3 preferences per year with a further option of placing trades. The Rodeo program and position draws for all events will be posted on the NRA website by Wednesday night prior to the Rodeo and it will be the responsibility of the competitor to trade out with another competitor if the wish to change sections. Barrel Race Trades: (Open & Junior) can only trade with the competitor of the same position draw in different sections, if trade is done with a competitor in a different position draw than both competitors will be placed in last position draw of each section. It is the responsibility of the competitor to advise the NRA office prior to 12 noon on Friday of any trades.

UNCOLLECTED PRIZEMONEY:

Any prizemoney not collected at Rodeos is signed for by the Central Entries personnel on the day. This money is sent back to the office. If the prizemoney is paid in cheque the cheque will be forwarded to the recipient as soon as it gets back to the office. No responsibility will be taken by NRA if the prizemoney is paid in cash. *Cash will not be sent by mail, it will be changed into cheque form and posted; a cost of \$5.00 will be deducted from the prizemoney for expenses incurred. Unless notified otherwise by competitor.*

DIRECT DEPOSITING MONEY:

When direct depositing money into our account can you please notify us by emailing the receipt with your name, amount and what the payment is for. This avoids any confusion and ensures the payment is assigned correctly to your account. Please ensure your name and membership number or reference number is in the payment description when completing a direct deposit. We do not accept any responsibility if you have transferred a payment and have not informed us, resulting in your nomination being cancelled from the Rodeo for not completing the payment on time

(for day membership payments or outstanding owings required to be paid by a designated date and time as notified).

CAMPING AT RODEOS:

When camping at rodeo grounds please respect the privilege to do so. Leave your area clean, tidy and free of rubbish. The last thing hard working committees should have to do is clean up messes left by the minority. Let's keep the grounds clean so everyone can continue to camp for years to come.

NEWSLETTER:

If you are not receiving a newsletter, please advise the office. You may not have completed a membership form or may have a change of address.

OFFICIALS:

Approved Officials are required to do at least one (1) event as an official per year to continue to be on the NRA endorsed officials list. Bull Fighters and Pick Up Men are required to do a minimum of five (5) Rodeos per year to be eligible for Bull Fighter / Pick Up Man of the year award.

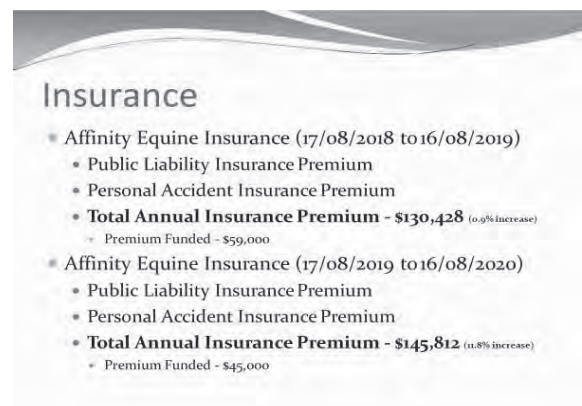
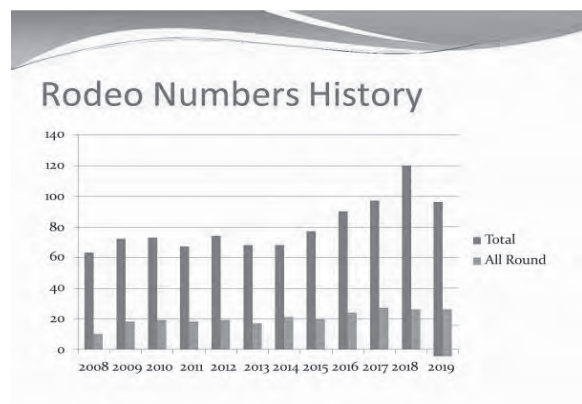

Shelley Harrison – Executive Director – Finance

Firstly I would like to thank the board for giving me this opportunity to serve as an Executive Director for the remainder of this year. I have enjoyed my time on the board.

The books for 2019 season have been audited by David Unwin and found to be a true and correct record of our trading for the year. We made a loss for the year of \$15852.37. Our debtors at the end of the year were \$15037.22 with cash in the bank of \$88749.83 and \$46006.33 in bonds held.

For the year the men's membership was up but all other memberships were down. This resulted in a down turn of income of \$3500 in memberships. Our rodeo operation figures were up for the year resulting in an overall increase in income for the 2019 season. The overall expenses for the year were up which is what has created the loss for the year.

The extra expenses this year have come from insurance. In past years we haven't been able to pay our insurance in full, paying part and then financing the balance and paying off on a monthly basis. Last year we paid \$71428 up front and financed and paid off \$59000 over this year. This year we were in a better situation financially and were able to pay \$100810 upfront and only finance \$45000 even with an overall increase in insurance of \$15000. The reason for the increase is the amount of rodeos we have on the calendar. The insurance is recouped 2 ways from entry fees from competitors and from committees taking out our public liability insurance.

I believe that moving forward the association is in a good financial state and will continue to prosper.

I move that we keep David Unwin as our auditor for the 2020 year.

Brett Gallaway – Operational Director – Junior Events

Good Afternoon all,

I think that generally, participation by juniors seems to be pretty strong in the NRA. I don't have official numbers but just looking through Judges sheets for the last couple of years, we seem to have similar numbers at the junior rodeos and competing in the junior events to last year. This year, we had an additional junior rodeo with Miriam Vale added to the calendar. This made a total of six junior rodeos for the year.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank everyone that has volunteered their time to officiate and help out at these junior rodeos.

The level of junior competition has been good this past year. We have a number of juniors competing with good success in higher age groups and in open events. I believe we have three rookie titles going to juniors this year. We have had a couple of juniors compete in the USA.

So, on the competition side of things, our juniors are going well. However, as we are all aware, there has been some behavioural issues at rodeos this year.

We have had one junior suspended for ten rodeos for underage drinking in the bar at a rodeo. We have had another couple of instances where juniors may have been drinking in bars but the proof wasn't there to suspend them. Overall, I don't think the problem of juniors drinking in the bars at rodeos has been too bad.

What has been a problem is juniors drinking and misbehaving at their camps. This has been a concern at quite a few rodeos this year. At the moment, the rule says a junior can be suspended for drinking in the licenced area at a rodeo but doesn't mention drinking at a rodeo in general. Do we need to look at changing this rule and how would we go about enforcing it?

I think that generally, this misbehaviour has been from a small group of repeat offenders. I think that for the most part our juniors conduct themselves very well at rodeos. If you compared rodeo to other sports, I think you would find that we have less problems with misbehaving juniors than the wider community does.

I would like to thank everyone for the help and support they have given me this year in my role as junior director. I'd like to thank my wife Kim for all she's done all year to help me out.
